B: To be honest, I <u>haven't really gotten into learning about</u> the geography of other countries. It just seems too distant from my daily life. For example, knowing the climate or environment elsewhere doesn't influence my day-to-day choices, like what to wear. Instead, I'm more fascinated by <u>the income levels of people in those countries</u>.

2. How do you feel about eating fish? (高频)

A: <u>When it comes to meat, I'm all about fish.</u> It's less likely to make you put on weight. I personally love grilled fish. It tastes amazing. Some people also like steamed fish or pan-fried fish. Any way you cook it, fish is <u>a nice, light meal that leaves you satisfied</u>. I really enjoy eating it.

B: I don't like eating fish. <u>I'm not sure what it is about fish</u>. Maybe it's the smell or the texture. But <u>it</u> really turns me off. I've had fish prepared a few different ways. But each time, I feel grossed out. It's just really <u>not my cup of tea</u>.

3. Have you ever visited a place where you saw lots of fish? (高频)

A: Yes, last summer, me and my friends were <u>hanging out by the river</u>. On one of our <u>canoe trips</u>, we saw a ton of fish around us. They were just swimming peacefully. One of my friends tried to touch one and fell out of the canoe! It was so funny.

B: No, I haven't been to a place with lots of fish around. There aren't many rivers or lakes around me. So I can't think of anywhere that has a ton of fish. Honestly, fish kind of <u>freak me out</u>. They move so fast and they look so weird! <u>I'm not a big fan</u>.

No: No, I haven't seen any movies with a bunch of fish. Honestly, I've always found <u>the way fish look</u> to be kind of strange, and some of them can even <u>give me the creeps</u>. So, <u>I'm not really into stuff about</u> the ocean. That's why I can't really think of any movies that focus on fish.

Topic 7 Helping others(新题)

1. What kind of help do you give to other people? (高频)

A: I'm the type who likes to offer help before people even ask for it. For example, if a neighbor <u>has their</u> <u>hands full</u> and can't open the door, I'll <u>step in without hesitation to give them a hand</u>. I don't wait for them to ask for help because that might <u>seem a bit distant or uncaring</u>.

B: I usually help people by <u>running errands for them</u>. If my friend <u>is overwhelmed with work</u>, I get groceries for them and cook so they can enjoy a nice meal. B: My parents <u>didn't really teach me</u> how to help others. They were very busy <u>keeping our family afloat</u>. So they didn't have time to focus on helping others. But they have always encouraged me to be kind. I think that helping others is how you can be kind to them.

After hanging out for a while, you realize that some people don't express thanks when you help them. <u>They act like they deserve the help</u>. So, if these people <u>hit a rough patch and I could step in</u>, I'm sorry, but I might not help them. **你喜欢帮助别人吗?**

B: I've helped my parents and elderly neighbors <u>by giving them tech support</u> since many of them have difficulty using cellphones and computers. They find modern devices confusing, so they ask me for help. <u>I don't mind volunteering my time and skills</u>. It's nice to help them out.

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Topic 8 Gifts(新题)

1. Have you ever received a really good present? (高频)

A: Yes, I've received a great gift before. I once had a friend make me a sweater. It was honestly so thoughtful. They embroidered my favourite flower on it, which was really sweet. It must've taken them so much time! I felt very loved when I got it from them.

B: I think the greatest gift I ever got was <u>a high- end watch</u>. My parents bought it for me when I graduated university. They knew <u>how hard I'd worked to get to that point</u> and they wanted to show how proud they were. I was so touched when they gave it to me. I wear that watch every day.

2. Are you good at choosing presents for others? (高频)

A: I think I'm pretty good at choosing gifts. The main thing is to choose something that <u>speaks to the person's</u> <u>specific interests and hobbies</u>. Giving them something basic like a candle or a mug isn't that special. But if you give them something that shows you pay attention to what they like, then <u>it makes for a great gift</u>.

B: <u>I'm not that great at</u> choosing gifts. I have a terrible memory, so it's hard for me to remember what people like and dislike. I usually <u>get them something safe but basic</u>, like a candle or a mug. It's also easy to get someone a gift card so they can choose what to buy for themselves.

B: I usually go for fancier and somewhat pricier gifts when giving to others. For example, a <u>well-designed</u> <u>branded</u> T-shirt or a beautiful European-style teapot that <u>could be a collectible</u>. I think things from fancy brands often have unique designs and <u>are more likely to bring joy to the person receiving the gift</u>. 你会为朋友买什么样的礼物?

4. Have you ever given someone a present that you made yourself? (高频)

A: Yes, I've sent handmade gifts to others. I really like to knit. So I've knit hats and scarves for my family and friends. They always like getting these handmade items because they feel special. They know how much time and energy I put into them. That's what makes the gifts stand out....→推總通告通知資店舖願創し ove

B: No, I've never sent handmade gifts before. <u>I'm not a very crafty person</u>. I don't know how to make gifts by myself. So I usually just <u>get people store-bought gifts</u>. They may not be as personal. But at least I know they'll be high quality. People usually enjoy what I get them.

Topic 9 Musical instrument (新题)

1. Do you know how to play any musical instruments? (高频)

A: No, I've never learned to play a musical instrument. <u>It's been a goal of mine for a while</u>, but I've just never found the time. <u>I always have a lot on my plate</u>. But if I had the chance, I'd love to learn how to play guitar. It's a fun instrument and it doesn't look that hard to play.

B: Yes, I know how to play a couple different instruments. I can play both the guitar and the ukulele. They're pretty similar to each other. The guitar just has more <u>strings</u>. But <u>the basic concept is the same</u>. I'd love to learn how to play piano as well. I think it's a really cool instrument.

你会弹奏任何乐器吗?

▲: 不,我从没学过。<u>我一直想学(是我的一个目标)</u>,但就是没时间。<u>我总是很忙</u>。但如果有 机会,我会喜欢学吉他。它看起来很好玩,也不是很难。

B: 是的,我会弹几种乐器,吉他和尤克里里。这两者很像,吉他就是多了几根弦,但基本概念
<u>是一样的</u>。我还想学钢琴,觉得它很酷。

2. Have you learned about music at school? (高频)

A: Yes, I have been lucky enough to study music from kindergarten through high school. In these music classes, I picked up various skills like <u>reading sheet music</u>, singing, and even trying out different musical instruments. <u>One special memory I have is</u> when my middle school music teacher taught us how to play the flute, which was <u>truly an enriching experience</u>.

B: <u>Back in school</u>, I didn't have many opportunities to learn about music. The primary reason was that <u>my school prioritized traditional subjects like</u> Chinese, Math, and English, so they often <u>pushed music</u> <u>classes aside to make space for</u> those fundamental subjects. This was somewhat disappointing, as I've always found music to be both captivating and <u>soothing</u>.

你在学校学过音乐吗?

A: 是的,我从幼儿园到高中都学过。在音乐课上,我学了<u>如何看乐谱</u>、唱歌和尝试不同的乐器。 我印象最深的是上中学时,老师教我们吹笛子,那是很有意思的体验。

B: 我<u>以前</u>在学校没有学过音乐。因为<u>学校更看重传统基础科目</u>,所以音乐课<u>常被放到一边,为</u> 那些更重要的基础课程腾空间(被其他课占了)。这让人很失望,因为我一直觉得音乐很吸引人, 并且可以让人心情很放松很平静。



3. Do you think all children should have music lessons at school? (高频)

A: Yes, it's important for schools to expose students to all kinds of skills so they can find out what they are passionate about. <u>How else will they find their destiny?</u> For example, imagine Yo-Yo Ma had never taken a music class. <u>The world would have missed out on all his beautiful music</u>, and he might be stuck in an unfulfilling job.

B: No, music is not for everyone, and children shouldn't be forced to take part in activities that don't inspire them. <u>Unlike math for example</u>, music isn't necessary to someone's success in society and most jobs don't require music knowledge. It's better to <u>give students elective subjects</u> where they can choose whatever they are interested in.

你认为所有的孩子在学校都应该上音乐课吗?

A: 是的,学校应该教孩子们各种技能来让他们发现自己真正热爱的东西。<u>不然他们怎么知道自</u> <u>己喜欢什么</u>?比如,如果马友友从未上过音乐课,<u>世界就会错过他的美妙音乐</u>,他也困难困在一 个自己不喜欢的工作中。

B:不,不是所有人都喜欢音乐。不应该强迫孩子们做他们不感兴趣的事。比如,与数学不同, 音乐不是一个人在社会上取得成功必须要具备的条件,大部分工作也不需要音乐知识。我觉得最 好是让学生们选择他们感兴趣的科目去学习。

4. Do you think it is easy to learn to play a musical instrument? (高频)

A: Yes, just like learning anything else, you start with the basics when learning to play an instrument. However, there are some instruments that are more difficult than others. For example, <u>the harmonica is</u> <u>pretty straightforward and intuitive</u> while the violin is <u>notoriously</u> difficult to grasp. <u>That being said</u>, if you find an instrument you love, sticking with it will be easier.

B: No, playing an instrument well is a skill that takes years to master. Just learning to read music is almost like learning a language. It requires rhythm, timing, and intuition. <u>On top of that</u>, you'll need to <u>build</u> <u>muscles and breathwork specific to your instrument</u>, and develop your own style. Learning an instrument is something that <u>definitely doesn't happen overnight</u>.

你认为学习弹奏乐器容易吗?

A: 是的,就像学习任何东西一样,在学习一门乐器时,你都是要从基础开始。但有些乐器比其他的难,比如<u>口琴学起来相对简单,看上去很直观知道该怎么做</u>,但小提琴就是<u>出了名的</u>难掌握。 <u>话虽如此</u>,如果你喜欢,坚持下去就会变得容易很多。

B:不,精通一种乐器需要多年的努力。就读乐谱这一点,都跟学新语言差不多。你得有节奏感、要对时间把握得当,还得有直觉(有感觉)。除此之外,你还得锻炼特定的肌肉,学会乐器的呼吸技巧,并培养形成自己的风格。学习乐器绝对不是一蹴而就的。

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5. What musical instruments do you like listening to most? Why?

A: I really like listening to the piano. It's so soothing. Whenever I listen to someone play the piano, <u>I feel</u> <u>like I'm truly at peace</u>. <u>The warm tones of the keys are so pleasing to the ear</u>. Plus, there's a lot of complexity with the chords. So it's also interesting to listen to.

B: I love listening to the violin. Some people think that <u>string instruments</u> are boring. But to me, they're the prettiest instruments in the world. <u>Violins have a lovely sound to them</u>. It always makes me relaxed when I listen to someone playing the violin. <u>I love how rich the music from them is</u>.

你最喜欢听什么乐器?为什么?

A: 我真的很喜欢听钢琴。那声音特别舒缓。每次听到有人弹琴,<u>我都觉得特别放松。琴键柔和</u>的音色特别好听。而且,和弦的变化也很有深度,所以听起来很有趣。

B: 我超喜欢听小提琴。有的人觉得<u>弦乐器</u>很无聊。但对我来说,它们是世界上最好听的乐器。
小提琴的音色很美。每次听到有人拉小提琴,我都觉得很放松。<u>我很喜欢小提琴传递出的有层次</u>感的音乐。

6. Do you think music education is important to children?

A: I think teaching kids music is important. Music <u>activates certain parts of their brain</u> and can improve their mental health. So <u>from that standpoint</u>, it's great for their well-being. Music also helps kids express themselves and be creative. It's good for them to <u>have an outlet like that</u>.

B: <u>I don't think music education is that important</u> for kids. It might be fun for some kids, but stressful for others. If kids don't <u>have a natural aptitude</u> for music, then they might get frustrated by having to learn it. It's more important for them to focus on subjects like science and math. Those subjects are much more useful.

你认为音乐教育对孩子重要吗?

A: 我觉得教孩子音乐很重要。音乐<u>会激活他们大脑的某些部分</u>,有助于改善他们的心理健康。 所以<u>从这个角度来看</u>,对他们的健康很有好处。音乐还帮助孩子表达自己,激发创造力。让他们 有这样的宣泄情绪的方式对他们有好处。

B: <u>我觉得音乐教育对孩子不是那么重要</u>。对一些孩子来说,可能很有趣,但对其他孩子来说可能很有压力。如果孩子<u>对音乐没有天赋</u>,那么学音乐可能会让他们感到沮丧。对他们来说,更重要的是专注于科学和数学等学科,那些学科更加实用。



Topic 10 Cinemn/Films(新题)

1. What's your favorite kind of film?/What type of movies do you like to watch? (高频)

A: I'm generally a fan of action films. You know, I really like exciting movies where there's a lot happening on screen. I love seeing car chase scenes or <u>elaborate fight scenes</u>. <u>It really puts me on the edge of my seat</u>. Plus, big action movies usually <u>have really cool effects</u>.

B: I like watching comedies. They might not be as exciting and dramatic as action movies. But they always <u>make me bust a gut</u>. Whenever I'm stressed from work, I just go home and put on a comedy. It helps me relax right away. It's good to watch something that <u>takes your mind off things</u>.

B: Well, when I was a kid, I rarely went to the movies. <u>On the rare occasions that I did go</u>, it was usually for a school trip to <u>watch a patriotic film</u>. But we mostly watched movies at home on TV. My dad used to rent DVDs of our favorite movies and watch them on the television.

3. Would you like to make a film yourself one day? (高频)

A: I'm definitely interested in the idea of making a movie, but it sounds really hard. Filmmaking involves a lot of different skills like <u>story development</u>, <u>camera work</u>, <u>and editing</u>. Considering I don't have much experience in these areas, I'm not sure if I'll ever make a movie. <u>But never say never</u>; perhaps I'll acquire the necessary skills in the future.

B: Yeah, definitely. Making a film seems like <u>an exciting venture</u>. I often find myself inspired by <u>the</u> <u>creativity of regular people who post short films online</u>. These projects are pretty encouraging, and they make me feel like if I could come up with a good story, I'd enjoy <u>turning it into a movie to reach a larger audience</u>.

你有没有想过自己拍电影?

4. Do you think watching films is a good way to spend time with friends? (高频)

A: Yes, going to the movies provides an excellent opportunity to <u>bond with friends</u>. Not only do you get to experience a movie together, but you can also <u>spend some time afterwards exchanging your thoughts</u> <u>and opinions</u>. I always find that I enjoy a movie more when I have my friends with me.

B: No, I don't think going to the cinema is a good way to spend time with friends. You just spend a couple hours not talking. <u>You don't even get to catch up with your friends</u> because it's rude to chat during a movie. I think there are better ways to spend quality time with each other.

你觉得和朋友一起看电影是不是个不错的消遣方式?

A: 对,和朋友们去看电影是个很好的方式来<u>增进彼此的关系</u>。你不仅可以一起看片,<u>看完后还</u> 可以分享各自的看法。和朋友们一起看电影,我总是觉得更加享受。

B: 我不太觉得和朋友去电影院是很好的消遣方式。你基本上就是静静地坐了两个小时,<u>甚至没有机会和你的朋友说话</u>,因为看电影时聊天被认为是不礼貌的。我认为有更好的方式来与朋友共度时光。



5. Do you prefer watching movies at home or at the cinema?

A: I like watching movies at home. <u>I'm more of an introvert</u>, so it's more comfortable for me to watch a movie from the comfort of my own home. That way, <u>I don't have to deal with noisy crowds</u>. It's also nice to be able to pause the movie whenever you want.

B: I prefer watching movies at the cinema. It's way more entertaining. You can <u>enjoy the benefits of a huge screen and a great sound system</u>. Plus, I really like watching a movie with a big crowd. It's so fun hearing everyone's reactions. I think <u>it makes it a better experience.oo0</u> 莱偲遇上寸上寸每實店舗讓創²

Topic 11 Loud noise(新题)

1. What loud noise can you hear where you live? (高频)

A: There are lots of noises around me. I live in the downtown area of my city. So <u>there's always some</u> <u>kind of racket</u>. It's mostly traffic and construction. But sometimes there's a lot of noise from people <u>being rowdy on the streets</u>, which makes it hard to fall asleep.

B: I <u>live out in the suburbs</u>, so I don't really hear that much noise. <u>At most</u>, I hear some animal noises. At night, you can hear birds and small animals outside. Some animals like <u>rooting through my garbage</u>. Sometimes you can hear people playing music from their houses, but that's pretty rare.

2. Would you like to live in a less noisy place? (高频)

A: Honestly, I haven't thought much about living somewhere quieter because my current place <u>isn't that</u> <u>loud</u>. There's some traffic noise occasionally, but <u>it doesn't really bother me in my daily life</u>. So, I don't have plans to move just for the sake of a quieter environment.

B: Yes, I've actually been thinking a lot about moving to a quieter place. My current home isn't great because it's close to a busy road and there's also construction going on nearby. <u>The noise is starting to get to me, affecting both my focus and my overall well-being</u>. So, I'm planning on moving to a quieter area soon.

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3. Do you think it's okay for people to make noise in public places? (高频)

A: Yes, it's okay to be loud in some places. For example, no one will be mad if you make loud noise in a public park. I always see children <u>running around and yelling in the park</u> close to my house. But making loud noise in a quiet public place, such as a library or hospital, <u>is considered rude</u>.

B: No, it's not acceptable to be loud in public places. You need to be respectful of the people around you. Playing loud music in a park, for example, is rude because some people might prefer to <u>enjoy some</u> <u>peace and quiet</u>. You should <u>save that kind of stuff for your own house</u>.

I really enjoy <u>cranking up the music to its</u> <u>maximum volume</u>. It's like <u>a healing way to let go of stress</u> and start fresh with a clearer mind.

B: No, I hate loud music. <u>I'm a pretty quiet person by nature</u>. So I don't like it when my environment is super noisy. Plus, I don't want to <u>risk damaging my hearing</u>. I don't understand it when people want to be around loud music. It just annoys me and makes me stressed out.

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5. Do you think there is too much noise in today's world?

A: Yes, especially in big cities. There is always noise from construction, vehicles, and people playing loud music. <u>It's rare to have a moment of peace and quiet</u>. Ads being played in public spaces also contribute to noise pollution. <u>It's not an exaggeration to say that</u> we're constantly surrounded by all sorts of noises.

B: No, I don't believe there's <u>an excessive amount of noise</u> in our society. Most of the noise we hear comes from construction and traffic, but construction isn't happening all the time, and traffic noise is primarily present <u>during peak hours</u>. Besides that, I find that the surroundings are generally peaceful. 你认为现在的世界噪音太多吗?

▲: 是的,尤其是在大城市。总是有来自建筑工地、车辆和人们播放大声音乐的噪音。<u>很难找到</u> <u>片刻的宁静</u>。广告在公共空间的播放也加剧了噪音污染。<u>毫不夸张的说</u>,我们一直被各种各样的 噪音所包围。

B:不,我不认为我们的社会<u>噪音过多</u>。我们听到的大部分噪音来自建筑工地和交通,但建筑工地并不是一直都在施工,交通噪音主要出现在<u>高峰时段</u>。除此之外,我觉得周围的环境通常还是相对宁静的。



Topic 12 Robot(新题)

1. How interested are you in robots?/ Are you interested in robots? (高频)

A: (Yes,) robots have always <u>piqued my interest</u>. They are an important part of our society today. After all, <u>life is full of tedious tasks that would be better left to robots to perform</u>. It gives us humans more time for important or enjoyable activities, like hobbies or spending time with friends and family.

B: Well, robots are handy, but I think we need to beware of AI technology becoming too advanced. For example, with the invention of ChatGPT which can imitate or replace humans, a lot of jobs will be lost. Besides, it has the potential to <u>be used to commit cyber crimes like phishing scams</u>. It's possible that robots will soon become more intelligent and powerful than humans. <u>Scary!</u>

你对机器人有多感兴趣? /你对机器人感兴趣吗?

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3. Would you like to have a robot to help you at home? (高频)

A: Yes, definitely! Robots can handle lots of cleaning tasks. You've probably heard about Roombas. They're neat little robots that vacuum your house for you. My friend has one and I can't believe how smart they are. They can <u>get around obstacles</u> and clean your floors so quickly. <u>It's definitely a time-saver</u>.

B: Yes, why not? Robots are really handy around the house. You can get them to clean your windows or your pool, or they can even <u>scrub your grill for you</u>. Honestly, I wish I could <u>have an all-purpose robot</u> <u>like the ones in science fiction movies</u> to handle all my household tasks.

After all, there have been some reports of deadly accidents caused by self-driving cars, so <u>it's not 100% safe</u>.

Topic 13 Running(新题)

1. Did you do much running when you were a child? (高频)

B: I haven't gone running in a long time. <u>I find it hard to make the time for</u> running. I prefer <u>doing exercise</u> <u>in shorter, more concentrated bursts</u>. So I think the last time I went for a run was probably a few months ago, to be honest. It's not a habit that I've kept up with.

Someone always has something interesting to say. Even if the conversation <u>dies down a little</u>, there's always someone to <u>pick things back up</u>.

B: I prefer chatting with just one person. In a big group, there will always be <u>someone who doesn't get</u> <u>heard or gets talked over</u>. It's hard to connect with others. When you talk with someone one-on-one, you can get to know them better. It's also easier to <u>keep up with the conversation</u>.

4. Do you ever have disagreements with your friend when you are chatting? (高频)

A: Yes, sometimes. <u>It's normal to disagree about things in any relationship</u>, and sometimes these disagreements turn into arguments. Usually my friends and I <u>argue about minor things</u> like what movie to watch or what restaurant to eat at. But sometimes we argue about more important topics like politics.

B: No, honestly, I'm someone who <u>tends to avoid conflict at all costs</u>, so if I disagree with someone, I'll try to just <u>keep it to myself</u>. Anyway, when I spend time with friends, we're usually just relaxing and trying to have a good time, so <u>there's no need to squabble</u>.

If someone has a different opinion, <u>I'll hear</u> them out. But it doesn't make me change my mind. <u>I just agree to disagree</u>.

B: If my opinion differs from others, I'll do my best to listen to their perspective and <u>take their ideas into</u> <u>account</u>. I mean, if we disagree, I'll try to understand why they have that opinion. Sometimes <u>it opens me</u> <u>up to new ways of looking at things</u>. I think it's best to be curious about different opinions rather than judgmental.

Topic 15 Tea or coffee(新题)

1. Do people like to drink tea and coffee in your country? (高频)

A: Yes, coffee and tea are the two most popular drinks in the world besides water. Since caffeine is so addicting, a lot of people <u>are hooked on it</u>, so I think it's something that will always be popular. Anyway, having a hot drink in the mornings is good for digestion and can help you wake up. Besides, <u>it's very</u> comforting.

B: No, I know a lot of people who don't drink coffee or tea. Most coffees and teas contain caffeine, which makes them less suitable for children. People also have to be careful about drinking them before bed or they might <u>have trouble getting to sleep</u>. Water or juice are more suitable drinks <u>for the general population</u>. 在你的国家,人们喜欢喝茶和咖啡吗?

2. Do you ever go out to drink tea or coffee? (高频)

A: Yes, I love going out for coffee. <u>The ambience in a coffee shop</u> is normally very pleasant. I like meeting friends over coffee or getting my work done in a cafe. Besides, I only have <u>a basic drip coffee maker</u> at home, so I enjoy ordering fancier coffees in cafes like lattes or cappuccinos.

B: Well, I love coffee but <u>buying coffee every day gets pricey</u>, so I prefer to save money by making it at home. The only time I buy coffee from a coffee shop is when I'm on vacation or on a road trip. Anyway, <u>I'm pretty particular about</u> how I like my coffee, so I prefer to just make it myself.

A: Well, in China, <u>it's customary to enjoy tea when guests come over</u>. So, I always <u>keep a diverse range</u> of teas available at home, and I regularly offer them to my visitors, including black, white, green, and herbal teas. Many of my guests show interest in the various tea flavors, and <u>it often sparks discussions</u> during our conversations.

B: Well, coffee seems to be the most popular choice among my friends, and <u>it's also my go-to beverage</u> <u>at home</u>. So that's what I usually serve my guests. I like making homemade desserts like cake, chocolate brownies or cookies to serve as well, and these treats <u>all go very well with coffee</u>.

It can also <u>be used to cure different ailments</u>. For example, <u>chamomile tea can help with insomnia</u> and <u>peppermint tea can help with indigestion</u>.

B: It depends. I love starting my day with a coffee because it helps me wake up, and <u>nothing beats the</u> <u>smell of fresh coffee brewing</u>, but I prefer to drink <u>herbal tea</u> before bed since it doesn't have caffeine. If I had to choose one, I'd choose tea because the variety of flavors means you don't get bored of drinking it.

I think <u>paper maps are quickly becoming</u> <u>obsolete</u>.

B: No, I don't remember having any maps on the wall in my home. As a kid, I was more focused on drawing whatever I wanted. My parents put some of my <u>doodles</u> on the walls. I always felt really proud when they did that. Even though <u>they were just scribbles</u>, my parents loved them.

B: Yeah, it's pretty easy to read maps. My parents <u>instilled that skill in me at a young age</u>. So if you show me a map, I can <u>find my way around</u> pretty easily. I also have a good sense of direction, which definitely helps. Honestly, I prefer paper maps over digital ones, which is pretty different from most of the people I know.

Besides, you'll feel better about yourself when you know <u>you look presentable</u>.

B: I love wearing clothes that are comfortable and <u>practical</u>. I prefer <u>loose-fitting shirts and more sensible</u> <u>pants</u>. I might not always be the most stylish one in the room, but I always <u>feel at ease</u> because my clothes are comfy, and they look good on me.

They are <u>adding improvements</u> like more stops and extended service hours to the public transport all the time.

B: Well, my school or workplace is situated <u>quite a distance from my home</u>. Typically, I have to change subway lines twice to reach there, so most of the time, <u>my daily commute takes around 30 to 40 minutes</u>. I really want to get my driver's license soon so that I can drive to work, which might make things a lot more convenient.

你家到上班/上学的地方有多远?

A: 我住在离我的工作地点不远的地方。我最近搬到了市区的一套公寓,所以我正好住在热闹的 地方(离哪都近)。我的城市交通很繁忙,我讨厌通勤,它让我感到很有压力!能够步行上班, 我感到很幸运。

B: 嗯,我的学校或工作地点<u>离我家有一段距离</u>。通常,我必须换乘地铁线路两次才能到达那里, 所以大部分时间,<u>我的每日通勤需要大约30到40分钟</u>。我真的很想尽快拿到驾驶执照,这样我 就可以开车上班,可能会更加方便。

4. Do you think people will drive more in the future?

A: Yes, people have always loved driving and owning cars, so <u>I don't see that changing any time soon</u>. The only problem is all the traffic in big cities. Maybe in the future we will have <u>flying cars</u>, then we won't have to worry about <u>traffic congestion</u> on the roads.

B: No, I think there will be fewer people driving in the future, and public transit systems are getting more advanced. As the world's population grows, personal cars for everyone <u>cannot be sustainable</u>. There is already too much traffic in big cities. Besides, people are becoming more <u>environmentally conscious</u>, and public transport is better for the Earth.

你认为将来人们会更多地开车吗?

A: 是的,人们一直都喜欢开车和拥有自己的汽车,所以<u>我认为这不会很快改变</u>。唯一的问题是 大城市的交通拥堵。也许在未来,我们会有<u>飞行汽车</u>,那样我们就不必担心<u>道路上的交通堵塞</u>了。
B: 不,我认为将来会有更少的人开车,而且公共交通系统会变得更加先进。随着世界人口的增长,每个人都拥有私家车的状态<u>不可持续</u>。大城市的交通已经太拥挤了。此外,人们<u>越来越注重</u> <u>环保</u>,公共交通对地球也更有利。
