The development of online communication tools, such as video chatting, has empowered people to talk to each other in real time without experiencing any delay. They do not need to visit clients personally or shop in a bricks-and-mortar store to buy what they want. This means that a growing number of people can work remotely or shop in the comfort of their homes, rather than driving or using public transportation to offices or high streets. 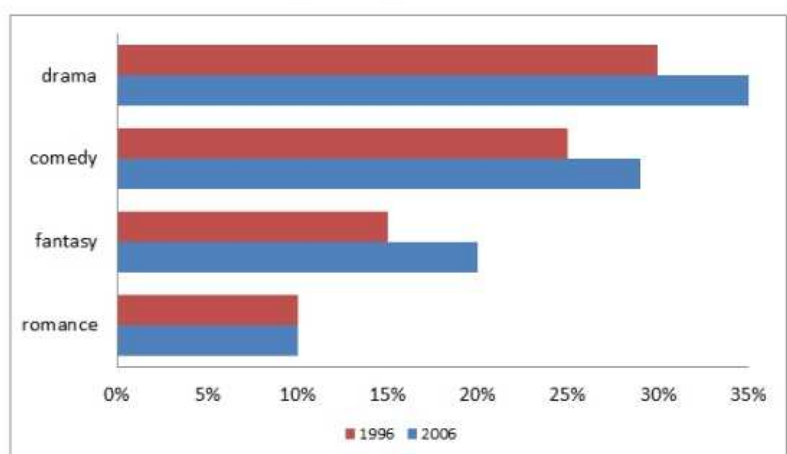
The bar charts compare the percentage of films released and cinema tickets sold from 1996 to 2006, including four film types: drama, comedy, fantasy and romance

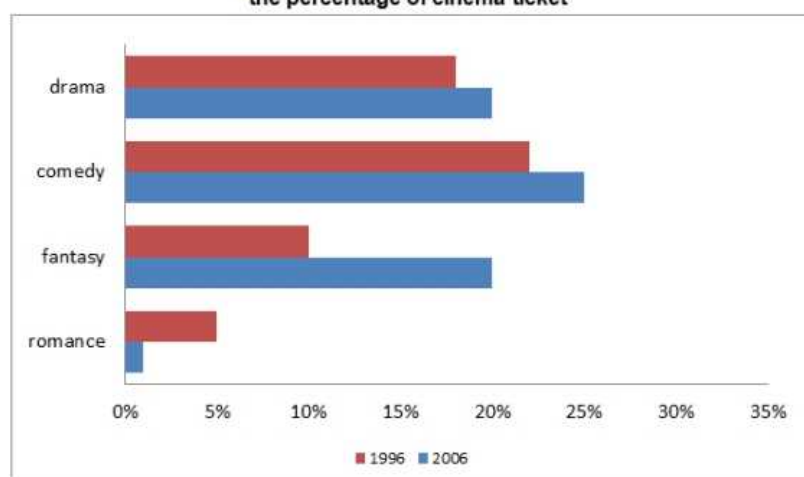
