### 1. Is camping popular in China?

No, not at all. I mean, I don't think I know a single person that's been camping! It's just not really something that people do here!

I guess it would be in a natural environment of some sort, like a nature reserve, somewhere like that, which was peaceful and scenic. And I would also choose to be in a designated camping spot, you know, where there were other people camping too, cos that would make me feel a bit safer I think!

***nature reserve*** – 自然保护区

I imagine one problem might be insects, especially mosquitos, which I really can't stand! And another problem, I guess, would be security, because a tent doesn't really provide that much protection! So there's a certain element of risk attached to it.

***Mosquitos*** - 蚊子
