• seize the day 享受珍惜每一题: to make the most of the present moment

I love waking up early and <u>seize the day</u>.

• Set the tone (for): 奠定基调

Mornings are the time when we <u>set the tone</u> for rest of the day.

1. Do you often stay up?

 Yeh I'm a <u>night owl/night person</u> for sure! I <u>stay up</u> almost every night until 2 or 3 am; sometimes I even <u>pull an all-nighter</u>. I just really hate going to bed. I don't know why. Sometimes, even I have nothing much to do, still I keep <u>procrastinating</u>(拖延), looking at my phone, <u>scrolling on</u> social media, <u>to the point that (以至于)</u> I can <u>barely keep my eyes open</u> (眼睛都几乎睁不开).(细节,原因) ② Uhmmn, <u>very rarely</u>, <u>almost never</u>. I'm a <u>morning person</u>. I really enjoy getting up early to <u>seize the day</u>. I do a lot of things in the morning. Only when it's some special occasions like New Year's Eve, will I <u>stay up a little</u> with my family at home. We <u>do the countdown (倒数)</u>, <u>exchange hugs</u> <u>and kisses</u>, and <u>wish each other a "happy new year"</u>. And after that, normally I'll go to bed around 1 am. That's the latest I can go. (原因, WH 法)

③ Not anymore! Haha! I mean, as I'm <u>getting older</u> now, I <u>can't afford to</u> <u>stay up anymore (熬不起)</u>. My body can't take it. Sometimes I won' be able to <u>fall asleep (入睡)</u> after staying up, and end up <u>tossing and turning</u> <u>(辗转反侧)</u> in bed for hours. And, <u>in addition</u>, I'll feel super tired and <u>drowsy</u> (昏头昏脑) the next day. I'll have to spend 1 to 2 days to <u>recover</u> <u>from that</u> (缓过来). When I was younger, I did it all the time and nothing happened. I was a total <u>night owl</u> before. (原因,时间分层)

2. Did you stay up late when you were a kid?

① Yes, I stayed up late a lot when I was little. Normally on weekends, and during <u>summer and winter breaks(寒暑假)</u>. My parents would stay up late, and so would I. I guess, they were really <u>chill parents(淡定的家长)</u>, and didn't care too much about my <u>sleep schedule(睡眠时间)</u>. We would watch TV together and chitchat in the living room. <u>Now come to think of it(现在想来)</u>, it was a little crazy for a little kid to go to bed that late. (原因,细节)

② Very rarely, <u>once in a blue moon(非常偶尔, 俚语)</u>. My parents were very strict with my <u>sleep schedule</u>. I was allowed to stay up only when it was Chinese New Year's Eve. I had a very healthy <u>sleep routine</u>(睡眠作息) when I was little. (原因)

3. What do you do when you stay up late?

 I wish I could tell you that I'm doing something really cool and interesting when I stay up, <u>but the ugly truth is that</u> I'm doing nothing much (我带是希望可以告诉你我熬夜的时候做的是特别酷的事情,但是丑陋的事实 是,我什么也没在做). Like I said, I <u>procrastinate (拖延)</u> a lot. Sometimes, I'm <u>scrolling on my social media</u>, and sometimes I'm watching some <u>meaningless comedy shows (没有意义的喜剧节目)</u> on TV. (细节)—

② Most of the time, I'll be chilling in my couch (在沙发上闲着), watching TV, or a movie, or being on my phone. Sometimes, I need to stay up to study. Occasionally (有时,情况不多), I need to pull an all-nighter, hit the books (为考试临时抱佛脚), and prepare for the coming exam. (主流情况,特 殊情况)

③ Like I said, the only time when I stay up is during traditional holidays. So, normally I'll be celebrating the festival with my family, socialising, exchanging gifts, hugging each other, sending good wishes to each other...things like that. (细节)

4. What does it feel like the next morning if you stay up late?

① It depends on WHEN I need to get up the next day. If it's early in the morning, then I'll be <u>dead on my feet(极度劳累)</u>, walking like a zombie (像僵尸一样走路). But if I can <u>sleep in(睡懒觉)</u> until 11 or 12 o'clock, I'll be fine. As long as I can get my 8-hour sleep, I'm all good(我没问题).(分情 况)

② As a person who usually doesn't stay up, I'll feel physically <u>beat up</u>(被 打一顿)the next morning. I'll be <u>dead on my feet</u>, walking like a zombie. I won't be able to think. My mind will be <u>slow and foggy(思维像一团雾)</u>. I don't like that feeling at all. That's why I try as much as I can to not stay up. (细节)

1. Is there anything that makes you feel happy lately?

① Yes, I recently <u>got a dog</u>, and his name is Michael. I just feel so <u>excited</u> <u>and thrilled</u> to <u>have him in my life</u>. He's been making my life so much fun. I enjoy doing everything with him. We sleep together, watch TV together, take a walk together. (养了一条宠物,用 get 动词。 原因,细节)

② Oh yeh, I've just <u>received/got an offer</u> from my <u>dream school</u> in the UK, and I've been <u>over the moon</u> since then. I <u>fought so hard</u> and <u>prepared so</u> <u>much</u> for this school, and now I'm in! It's been like a dream. (原因, 细节)

③ Yes, actually, many things make me happy, and most of them are just small things. I'm a <u>happy camper (乐天派)</u>. For example, recently, I finished a book. It talks about how to be a better thinker and communicator. It is very <u>informative and helpful</u>, and that makes me feel very happy and <u>contented (满足而快乐的)</u>. (举例子)

2. What made you happy when you were little?

lt was so easy for me to be happy when I was little. Candies, toys, cartoons, <u>play dates</u>(和小朋友玩儿), <u>getting a good grade</u>(考好成

绩), ...life was much simpler at that time. (列举)

3. What do you think will make you feel happy in the future?

① In the near future(在近期), I want to <u>get promoted(晋升)</u> and <u>get a</u> <u>pay rise</u>(涨薪). I've been working really hard in the same position for 3 years, so <u>it's about time</u>(该是时候了) to <u>climb (up) the ladder(往上爬)</u>, and <u>prove myself</u>(证明我自己). That will make my very proud and happy. (原因)

② My biggest dream is to become a <u>home owner</u>(有房子的人). Having my own space, living a happy and peaceful life, <u>building a beautiful family(建立一个美丽的家庭)</u> there. Not like some people, all they want is being successful and rich, I just want to have a home and a peaceful life. (原因)

③ <u>Passing this exam</u> will make me REALLY happy, hahaha!!! I can't wait to study and live abroad, explore the world, meet new people, and <u>spread</u> my wings(展开我的翅膀,意味着独立成长). <u>I can't wait to see what the</u> future holds for me(我迫不及待想知道未来是什么样子的). (原因)

自己结合实际情况回答,想买一辆车、出国上学、为人父母......

4. When do you feel happy at work, why?

这题只会问工作党

 I feel thrilled when I get paid, ahaha! When I see more money in my <u>bank account</u>(银行账号), I feel that all the hard work is <u>paying off</u>(所有辛 苦都值得了). And I'm happy to see that I have <u>financial security(有财产保</u> 障) and a good future. (原因)

② It brings me a strong sense of achievement when my clients tell me that I'm doing a fantastic job, or my boss tells me that I'm irreplaceable (不可替换), that means I'm a top performer (表现很突出的员工).(原因)

5. Do you feel happy when buying new things?

① Yes, I am a <u>shopaholic</u>(购物狂). Shopping definitely makes me happy. Sometimes when I feel moody, I will <u>swipe my card like there's no</u> <u>tomorrow(像世界末日一样刷卡)</u>. When I see all the shopping bags in my hands, I feel very satisfied. It can <u>lift/boost my mood</u>(提升、激增情绪)....

② Not anymore. I used to be a <u>shopaholic</u>. But now I'm trying to get rid of the habit of <u>impulsive shopping</u>(冲动消费). It's a waste of money and energy(浪费时间和精力). I don't need that many things. Now, I'm trying to <u>declutter</u>(断舍离) and enjoy the beauty of "less is more"(享受"少即是多"的美).(时间分层)

③I'm a <u>minimalist</u>(极简主义). I hate having too many things. I only feel happy when I buy things I really really need. I feel nervous and frustrated when I get things I don't need. (原因)

6. Do you think people are happy when buying new things? Most people feel happy when they buy new things. <u>Our human brains are actually wired/made to be attracted to novelty</u> (<u>novelty:</u> 新奇的事物,我们 <u>的大脑被设计成天生对新鲜事物充满好奇</u>). Buying new stuff means they can have exciting new experiences. But the problem is, nowadays, people are <u>over consuming</u> things (过度消费). <u>Consumerism</u> (消费主义) is actually making people UNHAPPY. The more people buy, the more they need, and the more they compare themselves with others. And that causes the <u>feeling of inadequacy and depression (自我价值感</u>不足和抑郁的情绪). That causes low self-esteem (自我价值感很低). (原因,反向思考)

1. What do you do to stay happy?

1) I'm a <u>happy person</u> in general. So, it's relatively easy for me to <u>stay</u> <u>contented</u>, as long as I can enjoy my life, do things I want to do, and see my friends and family. One thing that can always <u>lift my mood</u> is <u>going to</u> <u>the gym</u>. I guess, <u>dopamine(多巴胺)</u> really helps people stay happy. (细 节补充)

(2) I'm a <u>social person</u>, so I always need to <u>be with people</u> in order to stay happy and positive. I see my friends and family <u>on a regular basis</u>. And each time after talking with them, I feel very happy and relaxed.

③ For me<u>, having a healthy lifestyle and daily routine</u> is <u>the key to</u> being

happy(the key to sth./doing sth. 通往 XX 的钥匙). As long as I can <u>get</u> <u>enough sleep</u>, eat healthy, do exercise, and enjoy my life, I'm happy.

2. Can you stay happy all the time?

Although it's easy for me to stay happy, still nobody can be happy forever, all the time. It's just impossible. <u>Negative emotions</u> are <u>unavoidable</u>. Some of them help us <u>stay away from</u> danger, and some of them help us <u>keep getting better</u> and <u>keep improving ourselves</u>. <u>And plus</u>, we need those <u>contrasts between positive and negative emotions</u> in order to <u>recognize and appreciate</u> our gains, things we have (我们需要在正负情绪的 比较之间,识别和感恩我们的获得,我们已经有的东西).

3. Is it important to be happy?

Happiness is important. It's a <u>rewarding feeling</u> that everybody pursues, because it gives us enjoyment and hope, and help us connect with the world. 1. Do you like weekends?

(原因, 细节)

③ Well, I'm working at a <u>tutoring centre(辅导中心)</u>, so I need to work a lot on weekends. That's why I love the weekdays much more, haha! But it's just me. My <u>work schedule</u> is different. (原因)

④ Well, it's <u>a love and hate relationship</u>(又爱又恨的关系). On weekends, I have a lot of classes to go to. I have a <u>water colour painting class</u>(水彩画画 <u>班</u>), a guitar class, AND a Spanish class. I make myself very busy <u>over the weekend</u>(我让我自己在周末特别忙). I love learning new things, but at the

same time I don't get to rest and <u>recover from the weekdays</u>. (原因,细 节)

2. What do you usually do on weekends? Do you study or work?

4. Do you make plans for your weekends?

①Sometimes I do. I mean, if my I have <u>a lot of things going on(很多事情来</u> <u>发生)</u> the coming weekend(即将到来的周末), I will definitely <u>plan it out</u> <u>beforehand</u>(提前计划好), making sure that I don't <u>over commit(过度承</u> <u>诺)</u> and end up <u>having multiple plans overlapping(有多个计划重叠)</u>.(原 因)

② No, not really. I mean, my weekends are almost <u>always the same</u>, rest, work out, and see my family. So, <u>there's nothing much to</u> plan about. My life is very simple. (原因) Schools(学校)

We have our own gym and <u>swimming pool</u>. The teachers are <u>professional, patient</u>, <u>respectful</u> and <u>pay a lot of attention to our needs</u>(非常留意我们的需求).

The students are amazing as well. (原因)

③ Uhmmm, <u>it's not the best school</u>, if you know what I mean. <u>Things</u> <u>could be better at my school</u>. For example, we don't even have our own <u>sports field</u>(体育操场).

3. Do you like your teachers?

① Yes! They're the best! My teachers are <u>professional, patient, respectful</u> and <u>pay a lot of attention to our needs</u>(非常留意我们的需求). They encourage students to <u>think outside the box</u>. They <u>make learning fun and</u> <u>efficient</u>. (原因)

② 适合高中生: Yes, I love my teachers! They're so creative! For example, sometimes, our homework is DIY things (手工做东西). Like, when we take geography classes, we learn different countries and cultures, our teacher asks us to DIY things related to this country! ③ Uhmmm, not really. I mean, some are OK... and some are just <u>doing the</u> <u>bare minimum</u>(应付了事,做到最低能接受的范围). They <u>couldn't care less</u> <u>about</u> the students(完全不在乎学生). For example, I've been at my school for 3 years, and some of my teachers still don't know my name yet. (原因+ 举例子)

4. Do you like your current learning atmosphere?

 I love it! The learning atmosphere here is really <u>positive</u>. Not super <u>intense</u>, but students are pretty <u>hardworking</u> and <u>scholarly/studious</u>. However, <u>it doesn't mean that (不代表)</u> we don't know how to have fun. We study hard and party hard (我们学习努力,玩儿得也认真). At my school, there are more than 100 <u>school clubs (兴趣团)</u>. (转折)

② My university is a famous <u>party school</u>. So, <u>there's no such thing as (没有这回事)</u> learning atmosphere. Haha! The "partying atmosphere" is pretty intense, I'd say (派对氛围很浓烈! 幽默的语气). (原因)

④ Oh yeh, quite often! I'm a jewelry freak (珠宝狂人) / jewelry lover (珠宝 爱好者) / jewelry person (爱珠宝的人). And I have a wide collection of different types of jewelry (我有不同类型的珠宝的收藏), including rings, bracelets, earrings and necklaces. I enjoy <u>experimenting with different combinations (实验不同组合) / mixing and matching (混搭)</u> to create <u>unique looks (独特风格)</u>. (原因,细节列举)

⑤ I'm very passionate about wearing jewelry. I find that wearing jewelry is a way to express my personality and style. I often wear it to complement/match/go with my outfits. I like to choose pieces that are meaningful to me, and I have a lot of <u>sentimental jewelry</u> that I like. I also love to purchase <u>one-of-a-kind (独一无二的)</u> pieces from <u>local designers</u> (本地设计师). (原因,细节)

2. What type of jewelry do you like?

① I personally prefer <u>simple and minimalist</u> jewelry, such as <u>delicate</u> chains(精致的项链), <u>stud earrings</u>(耳钉), or <u>thin bands</u>(细戒指). These

types of jewelry can be worn <u>on a daily basis</u> and <u>go with any outfit(和任</u> <u>何打扮都可以搭配)</u>. They are also easy to <u>mix and match</u> with other pieces, creating a <u>versatile look</u>(多变的风格). (细节,原因)

② I love <u>bold(张扬的)</u> and <u>edgy</u>(先锋小众的) <u>statement jewelry</u>, such as <u>chunky bracelets(粗大的手链)</u>, <u>large earrings(大耳环子)</u>, or <u>statement necklaces(体现个性主张的项链)</u>. They're definitely <u>local treasures</u>, and they always attract a lot of customers. Oh yeh, there's also a very nice fruit store that I always go to in my neighbourhood. It's <u>mom-and-pop store</u>, but the fruit there is amazingly fresh. I always support this store. (细节)

② Not a lot. I mean, I don't really <u>pay attention to</u> small shops or little startups in my area. <u>I'm the kind of person who always goes to big stores</u>, <u>big companies</u>, <u>franchise stores</u> (连锁店), etc, cuz(because) I trust on their quality, they reliability, and their stability. I don't understand why people hate <u>mass-produced stuff</u> so much. <u>I don't understand what all the</u> <u>fuss is about</u> (我不明白他们激动的原因). (原因)

2. Do you prefer buying things in big companies or small businesses?

① I prefer small businesses. From a personal perspective, small businesses often <u>have a more personal touch (有个人的风格)</u> and can <u>provide more customized service (客户定制的服务)</u>. And also, they may be able to <u>offer more flexible hours (提供更灵活的服务小时)</u>, more <u>personalized attention (个人化的关注)</u>, and a <u>more intimate shopping</u> <u>experience (更贴心亲密的购物经验)</u>. From a community's perspective, I like to <u>support local economies</u> and <u>say no to mass-produced products (拒绝</u> <u>大宗生产的商品)</u>. Oftentimes, I feel that big businesses <u>lack the personal</u> <u>touch and individualized service</u> that small businesses provide. (分类讨论 比较)

And plus, I feel that I can trust on these bigger businesses to <u>deliver the same quality(提供一致的质量)</u> each
time I shop. So, <u>consistency(一致性)</u> is another important thing I care about. Finally, another reason why I choose big businesses over small ones is because I see them as more <u>stable(更稳定的)/reliable(可靠的)</u>, and therefore, less likely to <u>go under/ go out of business</u>(破产). There're just <u>too many uncertainties(太多不确定性)</u> with small businesses.(罗列)

3. Have you ever worked in a small business?

① No, I haven't. I've been a student all my life. I've never even had a <u>part-</u> <u>time job</u>. So, no. (原因)

②Yes, I worked at a <u>small bakery(小烘培店)</u> for a few months during summer holiday this year, and it was a great experience. The owner was very <u>hands-on</u>(亲历亲为的), and I was able to learn a lot about baking and <u>running a small business(经营小型生意)</u>. The atmosphere was very friendly and <u>I felt like part of a family(我感觉自己是家庭一员)</u>.(讲故事法)

③ Yes, I worked at a small restaurant and it was a great experience. The owner was very <u>passionate about the food</u> and it was a great opportunity to learn about <u>the restaurant industry(餐饮行业)</u>. It was a team, only 4 people including the owner, haha, but we were very close and <u>it felt like</u> working with a family.(讲故事法)

④ I worked for a small online company and it was not a good experience. The owner was very <u>messy and disorganized (很混乱)</u>. And it was difficult to <u>get clear instructions</u>. <u>The workload was overwhelming (工作量很大)</u>. Plus, I didn't feel like I was <u>making a meaningful contribution</u> (制造有意义 的贡献). I left the job <u>feeling burnt out (感到累透)</u> and <u>unappreciated</u>. (讲 故事法)

(5) No I haven't, but I'm curious about what it would be like to work for a small company. I worked for a large retail company years ago. I was able to learn a lot. However, the company was so big that it was <u>difficult to</u>

<u>navigate(不知道如何工作、行驶)</u> and <u>find the right people to talk to</u>. That's why I'm curious about working for a small business. (讲故事法)

4. Have you even thought about starting your own business?

①Yes, actually! This is one of my biggest dreams. I <u>consider myself a</u> <u>person who</u> has <u>an entrepreneurial spirit(我自认为是一个有创业精神的人)</u>, and I want to be able to create something new and innovative that can change people's lives(有能力创造出新奇创新的东西来改变人们的生活). Meanwhile, I'd like to <u>have a flexible work schedule</u>, <u>have more control</u> <u>over the business</u>, and <u>have the potential of being financially</u> <u>independent(有实现经济独立的可能)</u>. That's like the coolest thing ever! I want to be my own boss!(原因)

I know myself well, I would be <u>better off(更好、更适合)</u> working in a team environment without having to worry about <u>running a business</u>. (原因)

In China, when someone livestreams, viewers can send gifts to show their support. And we call these gifts "the little rockets". Basically, those streamers will get a lot of little rockets, and each rocket equals to certain amount of currency(真钱货币). They can <u>cash them out</u> (取 现)later.

How do I talk to my friends and family? Where do I get all the information? It's the same for my friends. (原因)

③ I'm very <u>keen on using social media(热衷于使用社交媒体) on a daily</u> <u>basis</u>, and so do some of my friends, but not all of my friends(不是所有的朋 友都热衷). I've noticed that some of my friends are trying to <u>cut down on</u>

(削减) their <u>screen time</u>(屏幕时间), so that they can <u>find more inner</u> <u>peace</u>(找到更多内心平静). Some of them even have deleted their <u>social</u> <u>media accounts</u> to <u>avoid the temptation</u>(删除账号来避免诱惑). I really admire that, but I can never copy that. <u>I'm the kind of person who can't</u> <u>live without my phone or my social media feeds</u>(我是那种离不了自己手机和 社交媒体信息的人).(转折,原因)

I'm not a big fan of social media. Maybe I'm a little <u>old-fashioned</u>? My friends call me "grandma/grandpa"(朋友们都管我叫"奶奶/爷爷"). I'm just not into all <u>the clickbait content</u>, those <u>sensational things</u>. Each time when I <u>scroll on the phone</u>(刷手机), <u>I'm flooded with all kinds of social</u> media feeds(我被各种推送像洪水一样淹没). It's <u>too much/overwhelming</u> for me. I see people <u>giving up on their privacies(放弃隐私)</u>, or even <u>making a</u> <u>total fool of themselves</u>(哗众取宠) in front of the camera...I just don't get it(我不理解). It makes me sad. (原因,周围人评价,分析感受) 2. Do you think you or your friends use too much social media?

① <u>I hate to admit it but</u> yes, I definitely <u>spend too much time on my</u> <u>phone</u> and <u>on social media</u>. I'm really <u>hooked on</u> those short funny videos online. They are meaningless, but they are <u>highly entertaining</u>. Sometimes I just <u>lose hours and hours of time</u> without realizing it. I really want to <u>cut down on</u> social media. It's <u>a huge waste of time</u>, and I could have used that time to do something more meaningful. (细节, 原因)

 Yeh for sure! Currently I've got 250,000 <u>followers.</u> So yeh, definitely I'd like to work in social media. I like the flexible <u>working time</u> and <u>work location</u> in this industry, and also, <u>I</u> <u>love the fact that</u> I can <u>have an influence on</u> people. (细节,原因)

③ No, not really. <u>That would be the last thing I want to do</u>. I'm not interested in this field at all. <u>It's not for me</u>. I'm 0 sociable, 0 <u>tech-savvy</u> (懂技术的), and I have no sense of marketing(我一点不爱社交,一点不懂电 脑技术,一点营销感知都没有)whatsoever. I'm definitely not qualified for this kind of jobs. (原因)

4. What's the most popular social media platform in China? Why? Off the top of my head (首先想到的), "little red book" (小红书) is super trending (流行的) in China, especially among females. It's kind of like the Chinese version of Instagram (中国版的 Ins). This platform is mainly about sharing pictures and short videos. People share everything on little red book, from product reviews (产品评测) to parenting (为人父母), from life philosophy (人生哲思) to travel tips (旅行贴士), from vlogs to Out Fit of the Day(OOTD), everything. People like how informative (信息量很大) it is. And also, it's like you can take a sneak peak at other people's lives (可以偷 窥别人得生活). And then, what else, Bilibili is another super popular social

media platform. It's like <u>the Chinese YouTube</u>(中国版油管) where people sharing all kinds of videos, usually longer videos with <u>quality content</u>(高 质量内容). It's a place where people can <u>learn things and get information</u> <u>in depth</u>(深度学习). <u>Self-education</u>(自我教育) has been becoming a major trend around the world, including China. (列举,细节,原因)

1. Did you do puzzles in your childhood?

Doing puzzles <u>helped</u> <u>me unwind</u>(帮助我放松), <u>lifted my mood</u>(提升我的情绪) and <u>improved my</u> patience(提升我的耐心).(细节,原因好处) 2 Oh yeh, I was <u>a big fan of</u> Rubik's cubes, I still am. I used to have probably 20 Rubik's cubes when I was little. I enjoyed the challenges and the fun. Solving Rubik's cubes could <u>take my mind off things</u>. I <u>forgot</u> <u>about my daily worries</u> when I focused on it. It was such <u>a great pastime</u> for me, and almost <u>therapeutic</u>. Sometimes I could spend hours playing with my cubes. ③ Not really. I mean, I had some puzzle games but in general I wasn't into puzzles at all. I guess I just didn't have the patience for it. Instead, I spent most of my childhood outdoors playing sports. (原因)

③No, definitely no. I'm <u>too embarrassed to learn</u>. And plus, <u>there's no</u> <u>point</u> for me to learn as I <u>have 0 talent in singing</u>. To be honest, I haven't even sung in front of my friends yet. (原因)

3. Who do you want to sing for?

1. What snacks do you like to eat?

①I love <u>salty snacks</u>. So, I love chips, pretzels, and <u>salted nuts(盐味坚果)</u>. My favourite flavour of chips is <u>salt and vinegar</u>(盐醋口味薯片). I know many people find it weird, but <u>I'm obsessed with it</u>. It's my "go-to" snack (首选零食). (细节补充)

②I love a <u>sweet treat(甜味的小美味)</u>, so, chocolate chip cookies, brownies, muffins and chocolate are <u>my kind of snacks(属于我的口味的零食)</u>. Especially chocolate chip cookies, they're my <u>all-time favourite</u>(永远最爱). Whenever there're chocolate chip cookies in my house, I always finish them <u>too soon</u>(吃太快). It's really bad(很不健康), I know, but <u>I</u> can't help it(情不自禁).(强调补充)

③I love <u>healthy snacks(健康零食)</u>. I love <u>snacking on(磨磨牙,吃点零食)</u> nuts and yogurt in the morning and before dinner. Snacks can <u>provide me</u> <u>with extra nutrients</u>, and also <u>control my appetite</u> for the next meal. (原 因)

2. Did you often eat snacks when you were young?

①Yeh I was all the time hungry, so I snacked a lot. But my parents never prepared snacks for me, so I bought snacks myself. I ate a lot of <u>unhealthy</u> <u>snacks/junk snacks</u>. I ate a lot of <u>dairy products</u>(乳制品) when I was little, for example, cheese, yogurt, and <u>milk and cereal</u>(牛奶加麦片). My parents were very mindful about my diet. They wanted to give me as much <u>protein and calcium(蛋白质+钙)</u> as possible so that I could grow taller and bigger.(举例子,原因)

③No, not really. My parents didn't want to <u>spoil my appetite for the real</u> <u>meal</u>(让我对正餐失去食欲). So, they almost never gave me snacks. I remember I was all the time starving. Being hungry was a major part of my childhood memory. (原因)

3. When do you usually eat snacks now?

Normally <u>between two meals</u>(两餐之间), whenever I <u>take a break</u>. 2.How would you choose names for your next generation?

If the <u>fortune teller</u> tells you that your child's destiny lacks either of these five elements, you might want to add it to your child's name. But nowadays, parents are more easy-going. Many of them just go through the dictionary and pick out the name they like. (举例子,时间分层)

4.Does anyone in your family have the same name as you?

No. I know that in <u>western culture</u>, it is very common to name your child after other family members to show respect, but that's not the culture in China. <u>It's actually the other way around</u>(相反), it is disrespectful to name your child after other family members in your family. 1. What's the weather like where you live?

①Where I'm from, in the north part of China, we <u>experience all four</u> <u>seasons</u>, but the winter is really long. People laugh when I tell them that <u>winter is our longest season</u>. It lasts about 7-8 months, from the end of October to the beginning of May. It snows a lot in winter. Summers are <u>nice and warm</u>, though, with little rainfall, typically around 25-30°C (发音: 25 to 30 degrees celsius). Spring and fall are short seasons(春天秋天很短). (细节)

②Where I'm from, in the south part of China, it <u>has a typical subtropical climate, w</u>hich means there're wet season and dry season. From May to October is the summer season. It's <u>wet, hot and humid.</u> It rains all the time. <u>Everything is wet, sticky and moldy</u>(所有东西都有点湿湿的,黏黏的发霉的); winter is drier, with <u>no snow</u>. I feel embarrassed to tell you that I haven't seen snow yet in my life. (细节)

③Where I'm from, in the west part of China, it has a typical <u>continental</u> <u>climate</u>. Winters are cold and dry, little snow. And summers are hot and humid. It rains a lot in the summer. (细节)

2. Do you prefer cold or hot weather?

① I prefer <u>cooler or colder weather</u>. I like to <u>wrap myself up</u> in something warm and <u>get cozy</u>(很温馨的状态). Both staying in and going out are great plans for me <u>in the wintertime.</u> When it gets too hot in summer, I <u>feel suffocated(窒息)</u>. <u>I tolerate cold weather(不怕冷)</u> much better. (原 因对比)

② I should've been born somewhere warmer(我该生在更暖和一点的地方). I love <u>the sun</u> and spending time outdoors in the sun, <u>getting a nice tan</u>
and a lot of Vitamin D. I don't overheat like some of my friends do(我不会 像我的一些朋友那样过热,中暑). I could spend all day under the sun. (原因对 比)

3. Do you prefer dry or wet weather?

① <u>I can't stand</u> the rain, so I'd <u>go with</u> dry weather. When I make plans, I always <u>base my decisions on</u> whether it's going to be a nice day or not. (原因)

② I love the rain! <u>As the saying goes(俗话说的话)</u>, "<u>there's no such thing</u> <u>as bad weather, only bad clothing</u>."(没有坏天气,只有穿错衣服) Some people say they feel sad and depressed on a rainy day. Not me! It's the best time to go for a walk or run, in my opinion.(让位驳斥)

4. Are you in the habit of checking the weather forecast? When/How often?

① Every day. It's one of the first things that I do when I wake up. I need to know the weather in order to plan and <u>go about my day(过我的一天)</u>. I normally check it <u>as soon as my</u> alarm <u>goes off</u> because I have a <u>weather</u> <u>app</u> on my phone. (WH 法)

② I <u>look up the weather</u> once in a blue moon(非常极其偶尔). It doesn't matter if it's sunny or rainy outside, I still have to <u>go about my day</u>.(原因)

③ Once in a while (有时), I'll <u>look up the weather forecast</u>. If I'm planning a trip or a hike, I wouldn't like to <u>get caught</u> in some <u>nasty</u> <u>weather (糟糕的天气)</u>. But most of the time, I don't check the weather. It doesn't matter if it's sunny or rainy outside, I still have to <u>go about my</u> <u>day</u>. (分情况)

5. What do you think are the effects of climate change in recent years?

<u>It's clear that/There's no doubt that</u> temperatures are rising worldwide. People, plants and animals will continue to suffer if we don't <u>stop/fix/tackle</u> (处理) climate change. (罗 列)

6. Would you like to visit other cities with different climates from where you live?

① Sure, why not! Since I'm <u>used to</u> experiencing <u>the four seasons</u>, it could be interesting to visit somewhere tropical. <u>Just to see</u> what it's like to live there. <u>I could see myself</u>(我能看见自己,想象自己) in Costa Rica where it's <u>beautifully warm</u> all year round.

② <u>I'd rather not</u> because other climates are too extreme for me. It's either way too hot(要么不是太热) or way too cold(就是太冷) and I don't think I could handle it!

1. What technology do you often use: computers or cell phones? (preference 问题)

 I <u>tend to</u> use my <u>personal computer(PC)</u> more often because of work/school. It's more comfortable to <u>draft documents(写草稿)/type</u> <u>things down(打字)</u> on <u>a proper keyboard</u>(在一个正儿八经的键盘上) <u>as</u> <u>opposed</u> to only using my two thumbs(手机打字只有两个拇指). (原因)

② If I had to pick one, I prefer using cell phones, well, smartphones, to be more precise (更具体来说). They're basically a small computer that you can take anywhere. They're light and fast. You have the world <u>at your fingertips</u>. You can communicate with friends and family; You can send emails; You can <u>browse the internet</u>; You can even shop online. I'm addicted to my phone. (原因)

2. What electronic devices have you bought lately?

①I recently bought a new laptop because my old one is about to die/stop working/<u>conk out</u>(高分词汇,停止正常工作). I investigated a lot of different brands and <u>features(特性)</u> before buying anything. Eventually, I had to <u>bite the bullet</u>(咬子弹,表示硬着头皮面对)and, luckily, I found a good deal at the store.(讲故事)

②I love <u>buying new gadgets</u>. And lately I bought a new <u>fitness band(运动</u> <u>手环)</u> for myself. First, it's a watch, so I can <u>keep track of time(追踪时间);</u> and then, <u>the GPS receiver</u> in the band can <u>locate where I am</u> when I'm running and walking; and then, it <u>tracks my heart rate(记录我的心率)</u> and

<u>calorie burning(热量燃烧);</u> and what else, oh yeh, it also

<u>monitors/records my sleep(监控、记录我的睡眠)</u>. So yeh, I'm pretty happy

with my purchase. (罗列)

3. Is there any technology you want to buy?

①I'd love to have a second laptop. One for home and one for work. I'll use the work laptop only for work, and the home laptop only for entertainment, like movies, games and social media. This way, I could separate my <u>professional life</u> and <u>personal life</u>, and <u>maintain my work-life</u> <u>balance better</u>. (原因)

②Yeh, <u>I wish I could</u> have an electric car. Even though I don't have the <u>budget</u> for it yet. But <u>one can dream(人是可以作梦的)</u>, right? I'm trying to <u>save up</u>, <u>little by little</u>. And it would be the coolest thing to own an electric car one day. It would help <u>save money in my pocket</u>, as well as take care of the environment.(先抑后扬)

4. Is technology important in your life?

① Without a doubt, yes. I use technology every day, at home, at work, everywhere! <u>I can't imagine a life without it.</u> How would I go to places? On foot(靠走路吗)? How would I contact my friends and family? By talking to them <u>face to face(靠面对面说话吗)</u>? I wouldn't have that much time. And how would I work? It would be impossible. (反向假设)

② I could live without technology. I'm a person who can <u>live off the grid</u>
(与世隔绝,不需要水电煤网的人,基本上就是在逃犯的生活标准). For instance,
I've <u>cut off</u> social media for years. I have a <u>dumbphone(傻瓜手机)</u> to make phone calls, and that's it. And I don't even own a car. I prefer
walking to places. So, no. I'd say technology doesn't mean a lot to me. (原因,细节)

③ <u>I've come to the realization that we're better off with technology(我们</u> <u>拥有科技会更好)</u>, but we shouldn't <u>feel dependent on it</u>. It's a tool that has to be used like any other tool: in the right way. That's why I frequently <u>do</u> <u>digital detoxes(做数字数码排毒,就是不用电脑、手机、电子产品的意思)</u> to <u>unplug</u>(拔掉插头) and <u>reconnect with myself</u>(和自己建立联系). So, yeh, it's important to me but my life isn't completely dependent on it. For example, I use a <u>navigation app</u> when I go to places, but I still have <u>map-</u> <u>reading skills</u> when I don't have my phone with me. (原因,举例子)

5. Is there any technology you don't like?

②It's hard to <u>narrow it down(做小范围,选一个来说)</u>. <u>On one hand</u>, technology is <u>undeniably(不可否认地)</u> useful in our everyday lives. <u>On the</u> <u>other hand</u>, there are some aspects of technology that I dislike, especially when <u>it has something to do with privacy(和隐私有些关系的时候)</u>. You know <u>voice assistants(声音助理)</u> such as Alexa or Siri? I find them <u>creepy</u>

<u>(令人毛骨悚然)</u>. And they're like <u>an invasion of our privacy</u>(对隐私的侵略). The fact that they're constantly listening to what we say and what they do with that information annoys me. (原因,举例子)

6. What do you think the trends in technology today are, compared to when you were young?

Technology is so much more advanced compared to when I was a kid. <u>A</u> <u>big trend</u> that I notice today is <u>the use of technology</u> in schools. Many young children learn using laptops and tablets at an early age. Some schools even offer coding and programming courses to students nowadays because it's a part of their reality and future.(举例子,具体化答 题)

I'm <u>more of a night owl</u>. <u>Nights</u> <u>are when magic happens</u>(魔力产生的时候)!<u>There's just so much going on</u> in the evening (晚上的事儿太多了), food and drinks, movies, gatherings, parties, meeting new people...I can never do those things in the morning. I can never be a <u>morning person</u>. I look like a zombie in the morning (我早 上的时候看起来像个丧尸). (原因)

2.What do you usually do in the morning?

①<u>During the week</u>, I go to work. I wake up around 7 am, have my breakfast, and then <u>rush to work(着急忙慌上班)/commute to work(通勤</u> <u>去上班)</u>. Normally I have a lot of meetings in the morning, as that's when my mind is the <u>sharpest(锋利)</u> and I feel the most energetic. I can <u>get a</u> <u>lot of things done</u> during this time. <u>On weekends</u>, I normally go to the gym in the morning to <u>seize the day</u>.(分情况)

②During the week, I have a lot of classes in the morning. Therefore, usually I'll be <u>taking my classes</u> during this time. And on those days when I don't have classes, I normally go to the school gym to <u>work out a bit</u>, you know, <u>seize the day</u>, <u>make the most of it</u>. And on weekends, I always <u>sleep in</u> (睡懒觉) to <u>recharge the batteries</u>. (分情况)

③I usually have a nice breakfast with my family. We <u>are the kind of</u> <u>people who must have a nice breakfast</u> every day to <u>go about our day</u>. And then, I'll go to the gym with my <u>gym buddy(健身伙伴)</u> Jessica/Mike. We spend 2 hours there, training(训练) and later stretching(拉伸). My mornings are pretty <u>chill</u> and <u>slow-paced</u>. I start working in the afternoon. (WH 法)

3. What did you do in the morning when you were little? Why? Well, I remember <u>it was like war</u>(像是战争一样) in the morning. I was always <u>late for school(上学迟到)</u>, always <u>rushing</u>(着急忙慌). My mom would be <u>scolding and nagging me</u>(责备,叨叨我). And then, I would <u>grab my breakfast</u>(抓起早餐) and finish it on my way to school in the subway. At school, there were so many classes in the morning. By the time when I had lunch, I felt <u>exhausted/beat up(累死).</u>(细节)

4. Are there any differences between what you do in the morning now and what you did in the past?

①Well, <u>come to think of it</u>, I still rush to work every day, and I have a lot of work in the morning. So, no, not really. I'm just a grownup version of me. my mornings are still like war. Haha. (原因)

②My mornings are much more chill today. I <u>take my time(花时间慢悠悠地</u>

<u>做事情)</u> in the morning, <u>seize my day</u>, enjoy everything I do. I used to hate mornings, but I don't anymore. (原因)

5. Do you spend your mornings doing the same things on both weekends and weekdays? Why?

1. Do you write a lot?

I love that feeling. (频 率,原因)

②Hmmm, not a lot. But I write every day. Every night, before bed, I will lock myself in my own bedroom, and <u>write a journal(写日志)</u>. It's like a diary, but I don't focus too much on how I feel. I just write down things happened during the day, and <u>lessons learned</u>(学到什么). (WH 法,细 节)

③As a university student, I need to write essays all the time. So yeh, <u>academic writing</u> is a big part of my life. But <u>when it comes to creative</u> <u>writing</u> (创造型写作), like creating a story or a poem, then no, I don't write at all. (分情况)

④At work, I need to write reports to my boss <u>on a weekly basis</u>. And we are talking about reports with more than 100 pages(我们现在说的是 100 页 以上的报告哦!很口语的语气). So, yeh, I write <u>tons of</u>(成吨的) words every

week. Sometimes I need to <u>work extra hours</u> or even <u>stay up(熬夜)</u> to finish my report. It's crazy. (原因。细节)

⁽⁵⁾Actually I'm trying to become a professional writer! A novelist. So I do a lot of writing practise every day. I enjoy <u>story-telling</u>. For me, writing is the best way to <u>express myself</u>. <u>Putting my wild imagination and ideas into words</u> is one of the best ways to unwind and <u>gain the sense of joy</u>.

(原因)

2. What do you like to write? Why?

I love writing novels, like I said, suspense, detective, basically <u>mystery</u> <u>stories</u>, and romance. I love how much freedom I have in mystery stories. Sometimes I will <u>travel to another time(另一个时间)</u>, or even <u>another</u> <u>parallel world</u>(另一个平行世界) to build my story. And I love writing romance, because I'm also a very <u>romantic person</u>.(原因)

3. Do you think the things you write would change?

①I would say so. <u>You never know</u>(你永远不知道). I'm also reading a lot, trying to learn more types and styles of writing. Therefore, <u>it's very likely</u> (很有可能) that one day I might <u>come across(偶遇)</u> some styles that I really really like, and just want to <u>give it a try/shot</u>(尝试). I'm very excited to see <u>what the future holds</u>(未来为我准备了什么,未来可期的意思). (原因)

②I hope so! I hate academic writing! Ahaha! I don't want to write essays and papers forever. In the future, I don't want to write anything anymore, actually. (原因)

4. Do you prefer typing or handwriting when you are writing?

①Sometimes when I'm just <u>scribbling</u>(随便写写画画) my ideas, trying to figure out some interesting plots, I'll write it <u>with a pen on a piece of</u>

1. What kind of public transportation do you usually take?

①I <u>regularly take the subway</u> to work. <u>Fortunately</u>, it's easy and <u>affordable</u> to <u>get around my city(在城市里转悠)</u> thanks to the <u>subway/underground system</u>. I really enjoy my little private time reading a book <u>on the subway</u>. Sometime I also <u>catch/take a bus</u> to go to places. Depends on my mood and also the traffic. (主流情况,特殊情况) ②This year, I've been trying to <u>reduce my environmental footprint (减少我</u>给环境带来的负担), so I've been <u>cycling</u> to work <u>more than usual</u>. Once you <u>get used to it</u>, you realize that it's very freeing (使人感到自由) and you save a lot of money. (原因)

2. When do you usually take public transportation: in your everyday life or when you are travelling?

① Uhmm, it's more common for me to <u>hop on the subway train or the bus</u> when I'm at home(在自己城市的时候). I need it to go to school/work because I don't have a car, so I have no other choice! I feel comfortable because I know the subway/bus<u>routes</u> and <u>schedules</u>. I've used public transportation in other cities while traveling and <u>found it overwhelming</u> at times. Plus, when I'm travelling, I prefer to <u>explore on foot</u>. You get to discover much more <u>that way(那样的话)</u>. (原因)

②I've travelled extensively(旅行的量很大) and always used <u>public</u> <u>transportation</u> more while abroad. When you're trying to <u>cram/pack</u> <u>many plans into one day(一天当中塞很多计划)</u>, you have to take advantage of all the different modes/means of transportation that the city offers. Otherwise, you won't be able to see a lot of places and things! When I'm at home, I usually drive my own car. (原因)

3. Do most people prefer public transportation in your country?

(1) would say, people in big cities <u>tend to choose public transport over</u>

private cars more than people from small towns or the country(乡村).

And the reasons are very obvious, parking is <u>a huge issue</u> in those big cities, and also, if you <u>use public transport</u> like the subway, you won't <u>be</u> <u>stuck in traffic during the rush hour</u>. But in those smaller cities or towns in China, you see a lot of people <u>driving their private cars</u> or riding their motorbikes or bikes. It's not that popular to <u>use public transpor</u>t. (分群 体) ②<u>Some do and some don't</u>, just like everywhere else in the world. There are always people who are <u>big supporters</u> of public transport. They take the bus or the subway as much as they can. They know that <u>it's a win for all (多赢局面)</u>, they save the money and the time on the road, and it's better for the traffic and for the environment as well. They can <u>see the bigger picture</u> (有全局观). At the same time, there are always people who <u>feel lazy</u> to walk to the bus station, subway station, they just want to <u>hop in their cars</u> and go to places directly (跳上车,直接去不同的地方). So, <u>it's</u>

<u>hard to generalize</u>. (分群体)

③Well, not most people, but many Chinese people consider our public transportation to be <u>one of the best</u> in the world. It's not only efficient, but also <u>fast, cheap and accessible</u>. A lot of people I know <u>commutes to</u> <u>work</u> by bus or by subway every day because they'd rather <u>take</u> <u>advantage of their journey to do something else</u>, and also <u>save the cost of</u> car insurance, parking and gas. (原因)

4. Did you take public transportation when you were a kid?

①All the time! It was very common for kids to <u>take the bus to school</u>.
<u>There was always more frequency</u> in the morning and after school, so we would all wait together and get on the same bus. That was a lot of fun.
And plus, there was a <u>subsidized bus pass</u> (对小孩子便宜的通票; <u>subsidized</u>
<u>补助的; pass 是通票</u>) for kids. So, it <u>made sense</u> (合理) for me to take the bus. (原因+补充)

其他原因:My parents were too busy to <u>drive me to school</u>;或者 they didn't own a car.

②Almost never/No, not usually. My parents didn't <u>let me travel alone</u> on public transportation until I was older. Instead, I <u>carpooled to school(拼</u>

<u>车)</u> with some other students. /My parents drove me to school every day. But when they <u>took me on a trip</u> during holiday, we used to take a train or a flight. 其他原因: I lived close to school. So I walked to school every day.

5. Will there be more people taking public transportation in the future?

①I would imagine so. Just look at the traffic now, it's ridiculous and getting worse every day. Therefore, I'm <u>100% certain</u> that we'll all have to use public transportation <u>at some point(某一天)</u>. We'll have to <u>pitch in</u>

<u>(出力)</u> and <u>do our part(尽自己的责任)</u> to help save the environment. Hopefully, the government will <u>incentivize(奖励)</u> using public transportation more. (现在看未来)

②I doubt it. Public transportation will <u>always be there as an option(会是永</u> 远的选择之一), but you have to <u>take into consideration(考虑到)</u> that nowadays new types of <u>electric and hybrid cars</u>(电动车、混合车) are continuously being designed and made. That will be the future. (现在看未 来)

1. What do you usually do on your birthday?

③I don't do a <u>full-blown(全面的,彻头彻尾的)</u> birthday celebration. Usually, I have a small <u>get-together</u>(聚会) with my <u>immediate</u> <u>family/nuclear family</u>(自己爸妈这一类住在一起关系最近的家人), usually at my parents' house. We have lunch, play a few games and then I open a few gifts. (原因,细节)

2. What did you do on your birthday when you were young?

① We used to have so much fun on our birthdays as kids. My parents used to <u>rent out a space</u> each year on my birthday so that all of my friends and I could get together and play. There would be a different <u>theme</u> each year and we'd <u>do fun activities</u>, as well as eat a lot of yummy food afterwards. And all of my friends would get a <u>loot bag</u> before they went home. My parents were the best <u>party hosts</u>. (细节)

② <u>Growing up(在我成长过程中)</u>, my family didn't <u>put a lot of emphasis on</u> celebrating birthdays. We would spend the day together and eat cake, but <u>nothing fancy/extravagant</u>(没什么奢华的) and no kids' birthday parties.(细节)

3. Do you think it is important for you to celebrate your birthday?

① 100% yes! (Totally/Absolutely/Definitely!)My birthday <u>means a lot to me</u> for many reasons. It's the perfect excuse to get together with friends and family. It also gives us the chance to <u>reflect on the past year</u> and <u>make a</u> <u>big wish</u> for <u>what's coming up ahead</u>. (原因)

② <u>Frankly speaking</u>, no, it isn't important for me. Every day is a gift. It's just another day for me. I think it's unnecessary(没必要)/ meaningless

(毫无意义的)/frivolous(轻浮的)/stupid to spend <u>tons of money</u> on birthdays and parties. <u>At my age now</u>, I <u>couldn't care less about my</u> <u>birthday</u>. (原因) 4. Whose birthday do you think is the most important to celebrate in China?

It really <u>depends on your age</u>. When you're a child, your own birthday is <u>the most significant one</u> to celebrate. And later when you grow older and <u>have a partner</u> (有一个伴侣), their birthday becomes the most important one. Otherwise, you <u>run the risk</u> of losing that person in your life because it's considered to be rude not to celebrate your <u>significant other</u>'s birthday (人生另一半的生日). And then one day, when you have your own children, your children's birthdays become <u>the number one priority/the</u> <u>first priority</u>, because if you don't, they're going to give you a hard time <u>(折磨你)</u>. It's like everywhere else in the world (全世界都一样). (分情况年 龄段)

1. Do you do some cooking/help your family cook at home now?

①Yeh, my parents are getting old, so I <u>do my best</u> to visit them <u>once/twice/three times a week/every day/every weekend</u> and help <u>prepare meals</u>(准备三餐). We like to plan and <u>meal prep</u> for the entire week. Eating <u>homemade meals</u> is very important to us. (原因, 细节)

② <u>I wish I could</u>, but I don't help my family <u>when it comes to cooking</u>. I live in another city/ I'm too busy with work. I even <u>order takeaway (or</u> <u>takeout</u>) 点外卖 or <u>delivery</u> (点送餐到家) <u>during the week</u> for myself. One day, I might move back to my city/ when I <u>have more time on hands</u>, I would help my parents cook at home. (先抑后扬)

③Well sometimes, not always. <u>To this day</u>, my mom is very <u>territorial(有</u> <u>领地意识)</u> in the kitchen, she prefers cooking alone. But, <u>once in a while</u>, I'll <u>lend her a hand</u>(搭把手) in the kitchen while we're preparing a special family get together. Otherwise, it'll be too much work for her. (原因) ④ I live by myself, and I cook at home sometimes, not every day. Cooking at home is cheaper and healthier than <u>eating out</u>. Each time when I cook, I just throw everything into one big pot, and <u>stir, stir, stir.</u> That's it, no techniques whatsoever. And I make sure I cook enough amount of food for the next day. (原因,细节)

2. Do you think your home is clean and tidy?

 I'd say so. I try hard to make my home clean, tidy and organized. My friends always say that my home looks <u>spotlessly clean (一尘不染)</u>. I'm a <u>clean freak (洁癖)</u> and, therefore, I have a pretty <u>strict daily/weekly</u> <u>cleaning schedule</u>. I love watching TV shows about <u>home organization</u> (家居收纳) as well. (原因,周围人评价)

②I hate to admit it but my home is <u>the opposite of</u> being clean and tidy (我们家是干净整洁的反义词). I find cleaning so <u>tedious and time-consuming</u> (又无聊又花时间). I'd rather spend that time going to the gym or taking a nap. And I love <u>stocking up on things</u>(屯东西). My friends call me a hoarder(集物癖). (原因,替代做法,周围人评价)

③ <u>I'm not the tidiest person in the world</u>(委婉说法,有点小邋遢). <u>There's a</u> <u>bit of clutter in my house</u>(家里有一点点乱), but I don't let things <u>get too</u> <u>out of hand/control</u>(失控). When I really need to clean, I'll <u>get around to</u> it(拖拖拉拉最后去做了该做的事), but <u>I won't go out of my way</u>(我不会太拼尽 全力).(原因)

3. Did you do some house cleaning when you were young?
① My parents asked me to <u>help around the house</u> from a very young age.
We had a <u>weekly cleaning schedule</u> and everyone had to <u>participate (参</u>
<u>与</u>) /do their part (做自己的份内) /lend a hand (帮把手). We even <u>got a</u>

<u>small allowance(挣零花钱)</u> for helping out. I helped my parents <u>do the</u> <u>dishes, do the laundry, fold the clothes,</u> <u>dust the house(弹尘)</u>, things like that. I'm grateful for all those skills that they <u>instilled in me</u>. (原因,细节)

② My parents never forced me to <u>do any house cleaning</u> when I was young. We <u>had someone help</u> us with the house. It was a lady, and she would <u>come over</u> to clean our bedrooms and <u>do the laundry</u>. It saved us a lot of time. (have someone do sth.在这里表示组织安排某人做某事) (原因)

③When I was little, every weekend, I would help my parents <u>do the</u> <u>laundry</u>, then <u>hang the clothes</u>, and later <u>fold all the clothes</u>. My parents used to be very busy, so I helped them with some chores. They paid me for doing them. That was how I <u>earned my allowances</u>. (WH 法)

4. Do you have breakfast at home every day?

①Oh yeh! as they say, "breakfast is the most important meal of the day". I do eat breakfast at home because I don't like to spend money at cafés/ because it's healthier than <u>grabbing something on the go</u>. It's always a wholewheat toast, a yogurt and some fruit. It's a <u>part of my daily routine</u>. (原因,细节)

②I'm usually <u>in such a rush</u> in the morning that I'm lucky if I get some coffee and <u>(get) a quick bite in me</u>(吃一口到肚子里) before I go. <u>Most of</u> <u>the time</u>, I just naturally <u>fast</u>(空腹禁食) until lunch time. I know it's not the healthiest lifestyle, but <u>there's nothing I can do about it</u>. (原因)

5. Do you want to learn how to cook well?

①You know, <u>I've always wanted to/I've been meaning to</u> learn how to cook well. Not long ago, I decided to <u>sign up for a cooking class</u>. It was mainly focusing on Chinese cuisines, but I also learned how to make Japanese Sushi and Vietnamese Pho(越南粉). I'm happy to see that I'm making progress on cooking. (细节) ② It's not a priority of mine to learn how to cook well at this stage of my <u>life(我人生的现阶段)</u>. I'd rather <u>order takeout</u> or <u>have food delivered</u>. I mean, I can definitely cook when it comes to preparing simple meals, but I wouldn't <u>take a cooking class just for fun(纯粹为了乐趣)</u>. (原因)

6. What housework do you like or dislike doing?

①Call me a weirdo but, for some reason(出于某种原因), I find cleaning therapeutic(有疗愈效果) and that's why I like <u>doing the dishes</u>, <u>doing the</u> <u>laundry</u> and <u>dusting the house</u>. I just <u>let my mind go(让思绪驰骋)</u> while doing those chores. It's a way of <u>meditating(冥想)</u>.(细节,原因)

② <u>There's nothing I can't stand more than</u> vacuuming the floors. It's so loud, boring, time-consuming that I'd rather <u>put up with a little dust</u>! Sometimes I just go mopping straight without vacuuming first. (原因)
