So, today I want to talk about a time when I decided to wait to buy a very expensive dress/shirt(男孩女孩内容可

以调整).

It was about a month ago, I was <u>browsing around at</u> the mall <u>aimlessly</u>(漫无目的地). And then, I saw a very beautiful/(cool) dress/(shirt) in one of the stores. It <u>was totally my style</u> (完全是我的风格), very <u>elegant but</u> <u>effortless</u> at the same time (既优雅又毫不费力的感觉). I tried it on, and <u>it looked SO good on me</u>. It was like it <u>had</u> <u>my name on it</u> (写着我的名字). I checked the <u>price tag</u> (价签), and it was very very pricey, like, <u>over-the-top pricey</u> (过分的贵了). I thought about it, and I decided to <u>sleep on it</u>, and not to <u>rush my decision</u> of buying it.

The reason why I decided to <u>control my impulse</u> was that I wanted to <u>make a change</u>. I used to be <u>a big spender</u>. Describe a historical period/moment that you would like to learn more about (感兴趣的历史时期)

You should say:

What you are interested in When it happened What you know about it And why you would like to learn more

思路:宝宝们可以选择一个著名的历史遗迹,然后围绕着该历史遗迹去展开对于其对应的历史时期的好奇。比如埃及金字塔,是如何

被建立起来的。很多人都说是外星人建立的,因为太宏大,4500 年前的施工能力,是如何把这个宏大的建筑建立起来的。找一个具

体的切入点,不一定要深入贯穿整个历史时期,也可以是一个 moment。讲一场战争也可以,看到了战争纪录片,可以就其中某个历 史人物,进行探讨。

So, <u>the other day</u>(前几天), I watched a documentary(纪录片), and it was about the Egypt's pyramids. And after seeing that documentary, I became very interested in that time.

To be honest, I don't even know the name of that period. I'm not a <u>history person/ lover</u>, sometimes I feel that I'm very <u>ignorant about</u> world history. And that's why I told myself after seeing the documentary, I should <u>dig/delve into</u>(进一步挖掘,表示更深入学习、研究) that time.

From that documentary, I learned that Giza(吉萨,地区), in Egypt, was the place where the Egypt's pyramids were built. They were built more than 4,500 years ago as <u>monumental tombs(纪念性陵墓)</u> where ancient queens and <u>pharaohs(法老 /ˈfeə.rəʊ/)</u> were <u>buried</u>(被埋).

Pharaoh Khufu(胡夫法老) started the first pyramid project around 2500 B.C.(公元前). His Great Pyramid is the largest in Giza. According to the documentary, they used 2.3 million <u>stone blocks</u>(石块), and each block weighed 2 tons(每块石块都是 2 吨重). Can you believe that? ...what a <u>formidable project</u>(多么巨大艰难、令人心生

敬畏的工程啊)?! I can't imagine how ancient Egyptians built that project 4,500 years ago. Even with today's <u>cranes(吊车)</u> and other <u>construction equipment</u>, building a pyramid as big as that would be a <u>dreadful(可怕</u>的) challenge.

That's why there's some <u>conspiracy theory</u>(阴谋论) saying that the pyramids were actually built by aliens(说 金字塔是外星人建的)! Which <u>I kind of understand where it comes from(我能理解为什么有这样的说法).</u> But anyway (不管怎样)...

That's why I want to learn more about it. I know that researchers already have discovered some <u>ramp system</u> <u>(斜坡系统,用来拉拽大石头)</u> 4,500 years ago that was used to <u>haul/drag</u>(托、拽) the stones out of the <u>quarry</u>

(采石场). But I can't imagine how exactly. Therefore, I'm going to do some research about that.

So, yeh, that's the historical period I'd like to know more about. Thank you!

So, the ad that I'm going to talk about today is an <u>online advertisement</u>.

The first time I saw it was a few months ago on a website. And then, I kept seeing it everywhere. On mobile apps, on different online platforms. <u>It's like, once I see it, I can't unsee it</u>. <u>It's everywhere</u>(就感觉是,一旦看到了, 就无法看不到这个广告。它无处不在).

I've been hating this ad since the first time I saw it, and the reasons are: <u>first</u>, I hate the jingle(主题曲). It's so <u>tacky and tasteless</u>(恶俗且没品位). It's loud and piercing(很吵). It gives me a headache(让我头疼). <u>And then</u>, <u>the testimonials(用户推荐)</u> in this ad are actors and actresses that are hired to pretend to be the real customers. They're so fake <u>to the point that it gives me the creeps</u> each time I see it (每次看到用户推荐的片段都浑身起鸡皮疙瘩). They're so awkward-looking(看起来很尴尬). And <u>there's no such thing as acting skills in the ad</u>(广告中毫无演技 可言). I hate <u>fake advertising</u>(虚假广告). <u>And finally</u>, I <u>can't put up with(忍受不了)</u> all the <u>exaggerated claims</u> <u>(夸张功效)</u>. It's <u>over the top(太过了)</u>! Traveling back in time?! No wrinkles at all?! That sounds like a lie. When an advertisement is saying all the impossible things, when it claims that it can <u>go against gravity</u>(和地心引力做 对抗), it's untrustworthy.

Anyway, I will NEVER buy anything from this brand. <u>They lost me</u> at the first second in that <u>lousy(极差的)</u> ad (他们在那个极其差劲的广告的第一秒就失去了我). Thank you!
