I said that **wasn't** fair because we **both** contributed to the garbage⁴, so we should take **turns** bringing it outside. My roommate was pretty **stubborn**⁵. But once I **calmly** explained that we should take **care** of the garbage not just because it bothered **me**, but also because it was **unhygienic**⁶, she **finally** agreed that we could **share** the responsibility.

Anyway, I felt pretty **frustrated** at the **beginning** of our disagreement. But I knew that it was **important** to be **civil**⁷ because I **like** my roommate and I want to have a **good** relationship with her. I'm glad we could talk it **out**⁸.

I took a **liking**¹¹ to her lesson because her way of **teaching** was **really** productive and **different** from ordinary English teachers in public schools. **Other** English teachers I've had are really by the book¹²; they focus on teaching students more about English **grammar** and **vocabulary**. **Lisa**, on the other hand, knocked it **out of** the park¹³ by making her lesson fun and interesting.

3.信息搜索

It had to be a **five-page** paper about a topic we had discussed in class.

We had to include at least **three** sources in our paper¹⁴, so I knew I needed to go there. Not only did I search for some **online articles** using one of the computers there, but I also went through the **shelves**. It was **hard** to figure out where to look **at first**. But thankfully a librarian pointed me in the **right** direction.

I picked out a few textbooks that I thought would be **useful**. It turns out that I actually gathered **way** too much information¹⁵. I only needed **a few** sources, but I had to spend a **lot** of time going through¹⁶ **all** of the articles and books in order to figure that out.

In that sense¹⁷, my research skills were a bit weak. I overwhelmed myself with too many things. But in the end, I was able to put together a pretty good paper, if I do say so myself¹⁸.

4. 校外学到的重要东西

Learning **new** skills is one of the **best** ways to **motivate** you to improve and keep life **challenging**. I try to learn at least **one** new skill every year in order to **push** myself¹⁹ and become the **best** person I can be. A **new** skill that I learned last year was how to play the **guitar**.

My good friend **Tony** has played the guitar since he was a **child**. He's always **encouraging** me to learn how to play the guitar. Finally, last summer, I decided to buy my **own** guitar and learn how to play. Tony agreed to **teach** me twice a week at his home where he showed me **everything** I needed to know about the **basics** of learning the guitar²⁰.

For anyone who has learned an **instrument** before, they know how **difficult** it is to play at a **high** level²¹. It can take **hours** and **hours** of practice²² if you want to become **talented** at playing an instrument, and the guitar is **no** different²³. Tony taught me the basics of **finger movement**²⁴, learning how to **read** music, and how to hit the **right** chords²⁵ while playing. It was **frustrating** at first since there was **so much** to learn, but he was **patient** with me and pushed me to do my **best**.

Now, I'm able to play **several** songs. It's **not** stressful to play. It actually helps me **wind down**²⁶. When I **focus on** playing guitar, I can let the **worries** of my day **leave** my mind²⁷. It helps me **manage** stress²⁸. So it's definitely one of the most **important** skills I've ever learned.

I talked to one of my friends, **Dan**, who's a very **active** person. He told me **not** to focus on having the **perfect** workout regimen³³. Instead, I could just pick **one** activity **per** week. It could be the **same**, or it could be something **new** every week. And it **didn't** have to be **too** intense. He said that even a **walk** after work could **count**.

His advice **helped**. I realized that I could fit in **short walks** while I took a break from work. Making **small** changes at a **slow** pace³⁴ helped me overcome my **anxiety** about working out enough. Soon, I had a **nice** weekly routine. I felt really **happy** that I found a **way** to work out.

I felt really **stressed** about my decision at first. I thought that maybe I was **overreacting**⁴⁰. But once it had been a couple **weeks**, I realized how **wound up**⁴¹ I had been. It was really **refreshing** to have some time **away** from school. After that **realization**, I felt very **relieved** that I had made this **important** decision.

I **didn't** stop thinking about school completely, of course. Instead, I took the **extra** year to research **different** schools to apply to. Now that it's time to **apply**, I think I have a much **clearer** head⁴² and I feel **better** about my choices. So I'm very **grateful** to my friend for giving me that advice.

But there was an **issue** with the **building infrastructure** that required some parts of the floor to be **shut down**. So one of my coworkers had to **share** my office with me. They added their **desk**, which made the space quite **cramped**⁷⁷.

Luckily, this co-worker and I get along **pretty** well. Her name is **Sarah**, and we have a **lot** in common⁷⁸. But even then⁷⁹, having to share an office added some **tension**⁸⁰. She would often take **phone calls** in our office, but she talked so **loudly** that I had to **put earphones in** so I could focus. But I could **still** hear her over the music I played, which was **frustrating**.
