I was walking with a **friend** at the time, so we took **pictures** of it and **posted** it on our social media⁴⁶ encouraging people **not** to be so thoughtless⁴⁷. We even asked if anyone was free to come **help** us pick it up. Even though it **wasn't** our job to clean, it really **bothered** us and we wanted to make a **difference** instead of just **complaining** about it⁴⁸.

In the end, I felt more sad than $angry^{49}$. It's just a shame that⁵⁰ people don't care about natural spaces. They feel comfortable littering, which is horrible. I think that people need to respect the environment more. After all, a clean environment is important for healthy living.
