2. How can we stop an argument from escalating into a fight?

I once saw a talk show in which a psychologist mentioned that we keep each argument within 3 to 5 sentences. That is, after arguing about three sentences about a matter, we walk away, because three sentences don't make it clear that the matter will not be concluded, and continuing will only escalate/'eskəleɪt/ the conflict.
