While children may sometimes <u>feel overwhelmed</u> by different instructions, these rules are ultimately for their own benefit. So it's important for children to follow these rules. As they grow older, they will understand their importance.

5.Do you think it 's necessary for parents to make decisions for their children?

1.你认为孩子们应该有很多玩具吗?

2. 孩子们通常在哪里玩?

Topic 2 童年趣事

1. Why do you think some people have a better memory than others?

I think some people have better memory because they <u>have high levels of concentration</u>. When they concentrate on something, compared to others, they <u>pay more attention</u> so they can better <u>understand and think about the information</u> they're taking in. This helps them remember it more easily. For example, if students stay focused during the teacher's lecture, they will undoubtedly have a better memory than students who are distracted by playing with their phones.

2. What kinds of things do people prefer to remember nowadays?

I think <u>meaningful experiences tend to stick in people's memory</u>. Graduating from university, getting married, and witnessing their child's first steps are memorable moments. People also remember things related to their hobbies and interests. For instance, if you enjoy fishing, you'll always remember the excitement of catching your first fish. These memories are special because they <u>represent important milestones in life</u> and make you feel proud and happy.

3. What can children do to improve their memory?

I suppose that with the help of teachers, children can do many things to improve their memory. For example, teachers can <u>play memory games like Matching Cards or Word Chain</u> to help students. These games often help exercise children's ability to recall information. Teachers can also <u>bring up lessons learned the day before</u>, encouraging children to review and summarize information. All of these practices are helpful for enhancing children's memory skills.

4.Is it important for people to remember the past?

Yes, we should remember the past. Remembering our personal past, both successes and failures, allows us to appreciate our progress and <u>helps us tackle challenges</u>. Additionally, remembering <u>our shared history</u> is important. It can help us avoid making the same mistakes. For example, World War Two happened because not enough people remembered the horrors of World War One.

5. What do you think we shouldn't forget?

One thing we should never forget is our childhood. It's a special time when we can experience the happiness and wonder of life. But as we grow up, the stress of work and study leads us to <u>forget that innocence and joy</u>. Honestly, I think that the more someone <u>holds onto their childlike heart</u>, the easier it is for them to stay positive and be more creative. So it's important to remember it.

6. Why do some people remember more of their childhood than others?

I think there are several reasons for this. Firstly, <u>people who had an eventful childhood</u> are more likely to <u>remember it vividly</u>. For example, kids who often went on trips or did lots of outdoor activities usually remember all the fun things they did. Besides, some children are really good at observing things, so they notice and remember more details about their experiences and events.

1.为什么有些人的记忆力比其他人好?

4. 谁不喜欢冒险?



Topic 5 汽车旅行

1. What benefits does public transport bring to the world?

Well, firstly, it reduces congestion in cities. It means less vehicles on the road and less parking lots. Besides, it can

increase productivity as passengers can use their travel time to work or read instead of focusing on driving. Another

benefit is that it makes commuting more accessible. After all, not everyone can get a driver's license.

2. Is it too late for people to get their driver's license at the age of 18?

I don't think getting a driver's license at 18 is too late. Before 18, people are more easily distracted and impulsive,

which affects driving safety. Imagine a middle school student getting excited about a new bubble tea shop and losing

focus on the road. This could lead to accidents. Plus, before 18, most people don't need to drive since they stick to

school and home. They can rely on other transportation options or get a ride from their parents.

3. What qualities does a driver need to have?

First and foremost, a driver needs to be skilled at operating the vehicle. They should stay alert and focused while

driving. Distracted driving is very dangerous due to unpredictable situations on the road. Besides, drivers need to

be calm and patient. Sometimes there are accidents on the road or traffic jams. A good driver should not <u>lose their</u>

temper due to these situations.

4.Do you think the government should make it a rule for people to use public transport?

I don't think it's a good idea. Firstly, some people need to transport big and heavy things. They wouldn't be able to

fit that on the bus or train. Besides, sometimes, people can't use public transport due to physical limitations. For

example, someone with a broken leg may find the crowded conditions uncomfortable. In such cases, a private car

is a safer and more convenient choice. The same applies to individuals with visual impairments and other disabilities.

5. Which jobs require people to be good at driving?

I think truck drivers and bus drivers need to have good driving skills. They have to handle larger vehicles than

private cars and face more challenging road conditions. For example, truck drivers often navigate through winding

roads. It's a real test of their driving expertise. Also, professional race car drivers should have extra skills. That kind

of driving is very fast-paced and dangerous.

1.公共交通为世界带来了哪些好处?

首先,公共交通减少了城市的拥堵。<u>也就是说道路上的车辆更少了,需要的停车位也更少了</u>。另外,公 共交通可以提高乘客的生产力,人们可以利用出行时间工作或阅读,而不需要专注于驾驶。另一个好处 是公共交通使通勤变得更加容易,毕竟,并非每个人都能考到驾照。

2.18 岁拿驾照是否优点太晚了?

我觉得 18 岁拿到驾照不算太晚。18 岁之前,人们<u>更容易分心和冲动</u>,这会影响驾驶安全。想象一下,一个中学生因为看到街边新开了一家珍珠奶茶店而特别兴奋,却忘记了专注于开车。这样就可能会导致发生事故。另外,在 18 岁之前,大多数人都不需要开车,因为他们<u>每天的主要活动都是在学校和家里</u>。这时候他们可以选择其他交通工具出行,或者让父母接送。

3.司机需要具备哪些素质?

首先而且最重要的是,驾驶员需要熟练操作车辆。他们在驾驶时应该<u>保持警觉</u>和专注。因为道路上的情况变幻莫测,<u>分心驾驶</u>会非常危险。另外,驾驶员需要保持冷静和耐心。有时候路上会遇到发生交通事故或者交通堵塞。一个好的驾驶员是不应该在这类情况下发脾气的。

4. 政府是否应该制定规则让人们必须使用公共交通?

我不认为这是个好主意。首先,有些人需要运输大而重的物品,公交车或火车是无法容纳下这样的东西的。另外,有时候人们由于<u>身体限制</u>而无法使用公共交通。比如,<u>腿骨折的人</u>可能会觉得拥挤的环境不舒服。在这种情况下,私家车对他来说会是更安全、更方便的选择。<u>同样的情况也适用于讲盲人和其他</u>残疾人士。

5. 哪些工作需要人们擅长驾驶?

我觉得卡车司机和公交司机需要有非常好的驾驶技术。因为他们<u>开的车往往要比私家车更大</u>,而且他们会遇到的路况也更复杂,比如卡车司机可能经常要<u>走盘旋公路</u>。这是<u>非常考验车技</u>的。另外,职业赛车手也必须要有出色的驾驶技能。因为他们开车通常都需要速度非常快,而且很危险。



Topic 6 传统庆祝活动

1. Is it important for children to learn traditional festivals at school?



High-paying jobs usually require <u>a higher level of education, expertise</u>, and responsibility. Professions such as lawyers, doctors and financial analysts usually have high salaries. <u>Commission-based jobs</u> in sales can also pay very well, although they may not offer a base salary. A good example of low wages for a high skill level is early childhood educators. 

Yes, I would say so. Over time, cities have become full of factories and <u>power plants¹⁶⁰</u>. Those places <u>fill the air with greenhouse gases</u>, which increases air pollution. Besides, there is much more air travel now compared to previous centuries. So that increases pollution too.

2.In what ways can air pollution be reduced effectively?

Air pollution can be reduced <u>in a number of different ways</u>. Firstly, people can take public transit or walking instead of driving. Secondly, I think countries can use better power sources such as <u>solar energy</u>, <u>wind energy</u>, <u>and hydro 161</u>. 
