3. Are there shops selling ice cream near the place where you live? ①Yes, there are several shops selling ice cream near home. Language (语言)

1. What languages can you speak?

3. How do you learn a foreign language?

①Well, my way of learning a foreign language is just like a child. I will <u>immerse myself in this language(沉浸学习)</u> by listening to songs or watching movies or videos in this language. And I will repeat what I hear, and try to <u>mimic the intonation and emotion(模仿语音语调和情感)</u>. And then over a certain period of time, I will start to <u>get the hang of it(上手)</u>. It really <u>works well for me(很适合我)</u> and that's the method I would recommend to everybody.(细节) ② Well, my way of learning a foreign language is like <u>a typical adult (典型的成年人)</u>, very <u>logical and 0 intuitive (非常有逻辑性,一点都不直觉性)</u>. First, <u>lay a foundation (奠定基础)</u> of grammar and then slowly <u>build my vocabulary</u> (建立词汇), and finally, I'll put <u>vocabulary into sentence structures</u> to

<u>form a sentence(制造一个句子)</u>. It's like math for me, and it's really <u>lacking imagination(很缺乏想象力)</u>, but it <u>works for me</u>. (细节)

4. How are languages taught and learned in your school?

In my school, we <u>take English classes and Chinese classes</u>. Well, Chinese is my <u>mother tongue</u>, so I don't have problems speaking or using it. But <u>when it comes to</u> learning English, I would say it is taught and learned in a very <u>counterintuitive way</u> (非直觉性的方式) in my school, AKA boring (换 言之, 无聊。AKA also known as). And <u>I'm not the most</u> patient person in the world (我不是很有耐心). So, I guess, the answer is no. (罗列原因)

2. Do you remember one of your teachers?

 Yes, I remember my high school English teacher. She was so nice to me and she <u>saw a lot of potential in me(看到我的潜力)</u>. We <u>had an amazingly</u> <u>strong bond/ connection</u>. And she even <u>formed a little group (搞小团体) /clique (小</u> <u>党派)</u> with those students. She was so <u>mean (刻薄)</u> to students who were outside the group. And we were all the time <u>feeling belittled (感到很</u>)

<u>渺小)</u> and <u>looked down upon(被鄙视)</u>, so it was a really bad memory, and I was <u>traumatized</u>. (原因,细节)traumatic experience

3. What were your primary school teachers like?

① Some were very nice and some were just okay(okay 表示凑合,马马虎 虎). I remember I had some teachers who really <u>cared about me</u> and <u>paid</u> <u>a lot of attention to my needs</u>. And they would <u>go above and beyond(做</u> <u>得超出标准)</u> and visit my home and talk to my parents about my performance at school(和我的父母聊我的表现), which I really appreciated. But there were also teachers who didn't care about who I was, or how my family was. They didn't even know who my parents were. They were just doing the bare minimum(凑活,干活干到最低标准).(分群体讨论)

②They were the best! My teachers <u>during primary school years</u> were <u>professional, patient, respectful</u> and <u>paid a lot of attention to our needs</u> (非常留意我们的需求). They encouraged students to <u>think outside the box</u>. They <u>made learning fun and efficient</u>. (原因)

②I loved my primary school teachers! They were so creative! For example, sometimes, our homework was to DIY things(手工做东西). Like, when we took geography classes, we learned different countries and cultures, our teacher asked us to DIY things related to this country! And then she would put them in the <u>school hallways</u>(学校走廊), <u>like an exhibition</u>(就像 展览一样)! One time, we were learning about Egypt(埃及). So, I remember the hallways were full of <u>cardboard pyramids</u>(硬纸板做的金字 塔)! Hahaha!(举例子)

4. Do you have a favorite teacher?

Yes, my favorite teacher was that high school English teacher I talked about just now(刚刚). She was like <u>a breath of fresh air(一股清风), a ray</u> of sunshine(一束阳光), very <u>caring and loving(</u>充满爱和关怀). I feel like we were <u>not just in a teacher-and-student relationship(不仅仅是师生关系)</u>. <u>It was more than just that</u>(比那还多). She was like my friend and also my family. I really want to <u>get in the zone</u> to study.

• throw myself into the task 投入工作学习任务中

Tonight, I really need to <u>throw myself into the task</u>, maybe I'll <u>stay up</u> (熬夜)/ <u>pull an all-nighter(熬通宵).</u>

• really go at it 全力以赴

I think you need a break from that school assignment. You've been really going at it for the last 2 hours!

- roll up one's sleeves 袖子卷起来 开干! 战斗模式!
- Have the attention span of a squirrel/gold fish. 有松鼠、金鱼一样的注意 力周期

2. 注意力不集中的原因

refocus.

- Too many distractions (太多干扰分心): You may be trying to focus, but if you're surrounded by loud noise, or if your phone <u>keeps</u> <u>buzzing with notifications</u>, it can be hard to <u>stay on task.</u>
- Not taking enough breaks (休息太少): <u>Working for long stretches</u> <u>(工作小时数太长)</u> without any rest can make it difficult to concentrate. Taking regular breaks can help <u>you recharge and</u>
- Lack of motivation (缺乏动力): If you don't feel motivated to do a task, it can be hard to stay focused.
- Too much stress (压力太大): If you're feeling overwhelmed with life or work, it can be hard to concentrate on anything. Taking some time to relax or practice a <u>stress-relieving activity</u>(减压活动) can help.

1. Did you stay focused in class when you were a child?

1)Yes, I always <u>tried my best</u> to <u>stay focused</u> in class when I was little. But it wasn't always easy, as kids normally <u>have very short attention spans</u> <u>(注意力周期很短)</u>. <u>There were times when</u> my mind just <u>started</u> <u>wandering(思绪开始游离)</u>/ I <u>zoned out(发呆走神)</u>/ I <u>spaced out(发呆走</u> <u>神)</u>, but for the most part, I <u>made an effort</u> to stay engaged in class. (主流 情况,特殊情况补充)

② No, I often <u>found myself daydreaming (find myself doing sth. 无意识地做 某事)</u> and <u>getting distracted</u> in class when I was a kid. I guess, that was just <u>how I was</u> back then (我以前就是这个样子的性格). I was all the time in my own world (在我自己的小世界里), reading <u>comic books (漫画书)</u>, imagining stories, or <u>doodling (随笔画画)</u> in my notebook. I guess, it's normal for a young child to have a very short <u>attention span</u>. (原因, 细节)

2. Are you a focused person?

①No, <u>I get distracted easily</u>(很容易分心), especially on things that are not challenging or rewarding enough. <u>I'm the kind of person who</u> constantly needs <u>new stimulation to stay focused</u>.(原因)

② I have to say, it's hard for me to <u>stay on task</u>. <u>The thing is</u>, I'm <u>all the time</u> <u>multitasking</u>, and <u>jumping from topic to topic</u>. The more things I do, the more difficult it is for me to <u>put my head down</u> in one thing. And plus, there're too many distractions nowadays, It's hard to <u>stay in the zone</u> when my phone keeps <u>buzzing with notifications</u>. (原因+补充)

③ No, not really. I'm <u>having increasingly shorter attention span</u> for sure(我 的注意力周期越来越短). I can only <u>get stuck in</u> things I really like, for example, watching entertaining movies and TV shows, or <u>working out in</u> <u>the gym</u>; or things that are so urgent that I have to really <u>knuckle down</u> to finish, for example, my <u>school deadlines/ work deadlines.</u> (举例)

④ Uhmm, I can be a very focused person once I'm determined(一旦我下决心 了就不那么难了). I mean, everyone gets distracted <u>here and there</u>, <u>now and</u> <u>then,</u> but overall, I'm a pretty <u>disciplined and productive</u> person. Therefore, when I need to <u>get things done</u>, I'll <u>roll up my sleeves</u> and <u>get into work</u> <u>mode(进入工作状态)</u>, and work like a machine. (原因)

3. How do you stay focused?

Well, for me, <u>it always helps(总是有用)</u> when I <u>make a full plan</u> for the things I need to do, otherwise, I'll just get distracted and <u>procrastinate/put off things(拖延)</u> until the last minute. But, if I <u>have a schedule to follow</u>, I'll <u>have a much better sense of time</u>(更有时间观念) and <u>better focus</u>, and be able to <u>throw myself in the task(投入任务)</u>. (反向+正向假 设)

② Well, the first thing is, I will always make sure that I <u>put my phone</u> <u>aside (手机放一边)</u> and <u>put it on mute/silent (静音模式)</u> so that I won't get distracted easily. I will <u>turn off notifications (关掉消息通知)</u>. That really helps me <u>stay focused</u>. I think <u>I'm a little addicted to</u> my phone. And then, I'll normally go to a quiet place, like the library or a nice and quiet café, to really <u>get in the zone (进入状态)</u>. Studying/working in a public place makes me more disciplined. I don't know why, maybe when I'm surrounded by people who're also studying or working hard, I <u>feel more motivated</u> to <u>stay focused</u> or <u>feel embarrassed</u> when <u>slacking off</u> (偷懒) ? And finally, I'll make sure I don't <u>overwork (过度工作)</u>, because <u>fatigue/being tired</u> can actually <u>decrease my focusing capability (劳累会降</u> <u>低集中注意力的能力)</u>. So, I'll always <u>take a breather (休息一下)</u> once in a while to recharge my batteries (重新蓄电). (罗列)

(以上三点,局部选择两点就好。不需要都说,时间控制在 25s-30s)

4. Is it easy to stay focused in a noisy environment?

① It can be challenging, I'd say. Those noises can be pretty distractive and annoying. However, with the right mindset or techniques, some people still manage to <u>stay in the zone(保持专注)</u>. For instance, some people find using <u>noise-cancelling headphones(噪音干扰耳机)</u> helpful, and some people just imagine people's <u>hubbub(人声)</u> as the perfect <u>white noise</u>

(白噪音) to help them concentrate. People find ways to <u>stay on task</u> in a noisy place. (转折)

② No, it's definitely difficult. The <u>constant distractions</u> and <u>interruptions</u> can make it difficult to concentrate <u>on the task</u> at hand(手头的任务).

He's so clumsy with fixing things. He always ends up making things even worse when he tries to fix them.

• Hopeless/ clueless 完全没希望、没头绪

She's so clueless at fixing things. She doesn't know what she's doing at all.

1. Can you fix things?

In the summer it rains a lot. It's really hot and humid during that time. And winters are cold and dry, very little snow. Something like that. (细节)

④<u>Where I'm from(扬调处理)</u>, on the east coast of China, my city gets <u>moderate rainfall(适中的降雨量,不多不少)</u> throughout the year. It doesn't rain as much as in the south of China, but we still experience <u>rainy</u> <u>seasons</u> with occasional downpours(有时的阵雨) in the summer time.

(细节)

3. Would you like to live in a place that is dry or wet?

① As a person who <u>loves spending time outdoors/is very outdoorsy</u>(喜欢 户外的), I would definitely prefer to live in a place that is dry. I find it easier to <u>make outdoor plans</u> when I know the weather is going to be <u>clear and sunny</u>(天气晴朗无云). ③ I <u>can't tolerate</u> wet weather. <u>Everything feels so sticky and wet</u>. I can even <u>smell the mold in the air</u>. Plus, it's <u>a lot hassle(很费劲)</u> to go out and <u>run errands</u> or <u>commute</u> when it rains. <u>It's not for me(不适合我)</u>. (原因, 补充)

1. How do you keep healthy?

Most people feel happy when they buy new things. <u>Our human brains are</u> <u>actually wired/made to be attracted to novelty</u> (<u>novelty:</u> 新奇的事物,我们 <u>的大脑被设计成天生对新鲜事物充满好奇</u>). Buying new stuff means they can have exciting new experiences. But the problem is, nowadays, people are <u>over consuming things</u> (过度消费). <u>Consumerism</u> (消费主义) is actually making people UNHAPPY. The more people buy, the more they need, and the more they compare themselves with others. And that causes the <u>feeling of inadequacy and depression(自我价值感不足和抑郁的情绪)</u>. That causes <u>low self-esteem</u>(自我价值感很低). (原因,反向思考)

1. What do you do to stay happy?

① I'm a <u>happy person</u> in general. So, it's relatively easy for me to <u>stay</u> <u>contented</u>, as long as I can enjoy my life, do things I want to do, and see my friends and family. One thing that can always <u>lift my mood</u> is <u>going to</u> <u>the gym</u>. I guess, <u>dopamine(多巴胺)</u> really helps people stay happy. (细 节补充)

(2) I'm a <u>social person</u>, so I always need to <u>be with people</u> in order to stay happy and positive. I see my friends and family <u>on a regular basis</u>. And each time after talking with them, I feel very happy and relaxed.

③ For me<u>, having a healthy lifestyle and daily routine</u> is <u>the key to</u> being

happy(the key to sth./doing sth. 通往 XX 的钥匙). As long as I can <u>get</u> <u>enough sleep</u>, eat healthy, do exercise, and enjoy my life, I'm happy.

2. Can you stay happy all the time?

Although it's easy for me to stay happy, still nobody can be happy forever, all the time. It's just impossible. <u>Negative emotions</u> are <u>unavoidable</u>. I like to choose pieces that are meaningful to me, and I have a lot of <u>sentimental jewelry</u> that I like. I also love to purchase <u>one-of-a-kind (独一无二的)</u> pieces from <u>local designers</u> (本地设计师). (原因,细节)

2. What type of jewelry do you like?

① I personally prefer <u>simple and minimalist</u> jewelry, such as <u>delicate</u> <u>chains(精致的项链), stud earrings</u>(耳钉), or <u>thin bands</u>(细戒指). 1. Do you know many small businesses where you live?

① Yes, in my community, there're some <u>boutiques(时装店、精品店)</u> that are really unique and <u>one-of-a-kind</u>. I love spending time <u>browsing</u> <u>around(闲逛)</u> in those stores. They're definitely <u>local treasures</u>, and they always attract a lot of customers. Oh yeh, there's also a very nice fruit store that I always go to in my neighbourhood. It's <u>mom-and-pop store</u>, but the fruit there is amazingly fresh. I always support this store. (细节) ② Not a lot. I mean, I don't really <u>pay attention to</u> small shops or little startups in my area. <u>I'm the kind of person who always goes to big stores</u>, <u>big companies</u>, <u>franchise stores (连锁店)</u>, <u>etc</u>, cuz(because) I trust on their quality, they reliability, and their stability. I don't understand why people hate <u>mass-produced stuff</u> so much. <u>I don't understand what all the</u> <u>fuss is about (我不明白他们激动的原因)</u>. (原因)

2. Do you prefer buying things in big companies or small businesses?

① I prefer small businesses. From a personal perspective, small businesses often <u>have a more personal touch (有个人的风格)</u> and can <u>provide more customized service (客户定制的服务)</u>. And also, they may be able to <u>offer more flexible hours (提供更灵活的服务小时)</u>, more <u>personalized attention (个人化的关注)</u>, and a <u>more intimate shopping</u> <u>experience (更贴心亲密的购物经验)</u>. From a community's perspective, I like to <u>support local economies</u> and <u>say no to mass-produced products (拒绝</u> <u>大宗生产的商品)</u>. Oftentimes, I feel that big businesses <u>lack the personal</u> <u>touch and individualized service</u> that small businesses provide. (分类讨论 比较)

② I prefer big businesses for the convenience they offer, such as <u>a wider</u> <u>selection of products (商品的可选择性)</u>, <u>extended hours (额外长的营业时间)</u>, and <u>multiple locations (分店多)</u>. And plus, I feel that I can trust on these bigger businesses to <u>deliver the same quality (提供一致的质量)</u> each time I shop. So, <u>consistency (一致性)</u> is another important thing I care about. Finally, another reason why I choose big businesses over small ones is because I see them as more <u>stable (更稳定的) /reliable (可靠的)</u>, and therefore, less likely to <u>go under/ go out of business</u> (破产). There're just <u>too many uncertainties (太多不确定性)</u> with small businesses. (罗列) 3. Have you ever worked in a small business?

① No, I haven't. I've been a student all my life. I've never even had a <u>part-</u> <u>time job</u>. So, no. (原因)

②Yes, I worked at a <u>small bakery(小烘培店)</u> for a few months during summer holiday this year, and it was a great experience. The owner was very <u>hands-on</u>(亲历亲为的), and I was able to learn a lot about baking and <u>running a small business(经营小型生意)</u>. The atmosphere was very friendly and <u>I felt like part of a family(我感觉自己是家庭一员)</u>.(讲故事法)

③ Yes, I worked at a small restaurant and it was a great experience. The owner was very <u>passionate about the food</u> and it was a great opportunity to learn about <u>the restaurant industry(餐饮行业)</u>. It was a team, only 4 people including the owner, haha, but we were very close and <u>it felt like</u> working with a family. (讲故事法)

④ I worked for a small online company and it was not a good experience.
 The owner was very <u>messy and disorganized (很混乱)</u>. And it was difficult to get clear instructions. The workload was overwhelming (工作量很大).
 Plus, I didn't feel like I was <u>making a meaningful contribution</u> (制造有意义的贡献). I left the job <u>feeling burnt out (感到累透)</u> and <u>unappreciated</u>. (讲故事法)

⑤ No I haven't, but I'm curious about what it would be like to work for a small company. I worked for a large retail company years ago. I was able to learn a lot. However, the company was so big that it was <u>difficult to</u> <u>navigate(不知道如何工作、行驶)</u> and <u>find the right people to talk to</u>. That's why I'm curious about working for a small business. (讲故事法)

4. Have you even thought about starting your own business?

①Yes, actually! This is one of my biggest dreams. I <u>consider myself a</u> <u>person who</u> has <u>an entrepreneurial spirit(我自认为是一个有创业精神的人)</u>, and I want to be able to create something new and innovative that can change people's lives(有能力创造出新奇创新的东西来改变人们的生活). Meanwhile, I'd like to <u>have a flexible work schedule</u>, <u>have more control</u> <u>over the business</u>, and <u>have the potential of being financially</u> <u>independent(有实现经济独立的可能)</u>. ② I've thought about it, but I know that <u>it's not for me</u>(不适合我). I'm a very <u>risk averse(害怕冒险的)</u> person. I hate risks, pressure and failures. I <u>never perform well under pressure(我在压力下永远表现不好)</u>. Being an <u>entrepreneur</u>(创业者) is too much responsibility and too much stress. I know myself well, I would be <u>better off(更好、更适合)</u> working in a team environment without having to worry about <u>running a business</u>. (原因)

Sometimes I needed to <u>cut a new key</u>(配钥匙). And then I would be worrying about people finding my keys and causing troubles.) (分情 况,细节)

③ No, never, I am a very mindful person. I try my best not to <u>leave thing</u> <u>behind</u>. That's why each time before I leave a place, I always <u>double check</u> (反复确认) my things.

3. Do you often forget keys and lock yourself out?

① Not really. It happened only once. And I called my landlord(房东)/ my mom/ my grandma to come over and open the door with <u>a spare key</u>.

② All the time! That's why I even have <u>a spare key</u> right <u>underneath the</u> <u>door mat (门垫下面) / underneath one of the planters (在花盆下面) in the</u> <u>front yard</u>, just like the solution in those Hollywood movies (就像好莱坞电影 里的解决方案一样). I know, it's kind of dangerous, but I don't know what else I can do about it. Change my brain? Haha! (细节)

4. Do you think it's a good idea to leave your keys with a neighbour?

① Well, it depends on your relationship with the neighbour. 1 Yes for sure! <u>I'm deeply fascinated by outer space</u> and want to know more about it. I'm curious about things like, the mysteries of the universe,

do aliens really exist, and the possibilities of moving to another planet. (细节)

②Where I'm from, in the south part of China, it <u>has a typical subtropical climate, w</u>hich means there're wet season and dry season. From May to October is the summer season. It's <u>wet, hot and humid.</u> It rains all the time. <u>Everything is wet, sticky and moldy</u>(所有东西都有点湿湿的,黏黏的发霉的); winter is drier, with <u>no snow</u>. I feel embarrassed to tell you that I haven't seen snow yet in my life. (细节)

③Where I'm from, in the west part of China, it has a typical <u>continental</u> <u>climate</u>. Winters are cold and dry, little snow. And summers are hot and humid. It rains a lot in the summer. (细节)

2. Do you prefer cold or hot weather?

① I prefer <u>cooler or colder weather</u>. I like to <u>wrap myself up</u> in something warm and <u>get cozy</u>(很温馨的状态). Both staying in and going out are great plans for me <u>in the wintertime.</u> When it gets too hot in summer, I <u>feel suffocated(窒息)</u>. <u>I tolerate cold weather(不怕冷)</u> much better.(原 因对比)

② I should've been born somewhere warmer(我该生在更暖和一点的地方). I love <u>the sun</u> and spending time outdoors in the sun, <u>getting a nice tan</u> and a lot of Vitamin D. I don't overheat like some of my friends do(我不会像我的一些朋友那样过热,中暑). I could spend all day under the sun. (原因对比)

3. Do you prefer dry or wet weather?

① <u>I can't stand</u> the rain, so I'd <u>go with</u> dry weather. When I make plans, I always <u>base my decisions on</u> whether it's going to be a nice day or not. (原因)

② I love the rain! <u>As the saying goes(俗话说的话)</u>, "<u>there's no such thing</u> <u>as bad weather, only bad clothing</u>."(没有坏天气,只有穿错衣服) Some people say they feel sad and depressed on a rainy day. Not me! It's the best time to go for a walk or run, in my opinion. (让位驳斥)
