
1. 按照故事顺序来自然展开

2. 四转大法 (适合"干燥"的话题)

既,结合 cue card 上四个小问进行逐一回答

注意:无须四问都覆盖;更无须按照顺序回答

Finally, +以上开头...

Anyway, ... (用于转话题)用一次差不多了

That's pretty much everything/ the story/ it, thank you!

四、每一段展开思路 (前四天的 p1+p3 联合打法都可以借鉴)

1. WH 法:

例如:

<u>As for</u> where this restaurant is, it's <u>located in the south of my city</u> (地点), not far from the city centre. I always go to this restaurant with my parents, on weekends, on birthdays, or on some special occasions, like traditional festivals or my parents' wedding anniversary. It's got a really nice and inviting environment, and the food is amazing. It's our favorite spot in the city.

2. 阐述原因 + 分层展开

We did ... because...

The reason why ... is that...

例如:

-The reason why I want to <u>grasp cooking skills</u> is that I'm planning to study in the UK this year, and I want to be able to feed myself when I'm there. Growing up as the only child in my family, my parents have been <u>spoiling me(宠爱)</u> so much to the point that I've never cooked in my life. All I know about cooking is <u>making instant noodles</u>(泡面) and <u>ordering</u> takeout (点外卖).

- And moving on to the reasons why I liked her so much, well, <u>number one</u>, she was so <u>comfortable to be with</u> (相处起来很舒服). She was the most <u>down-to-earth</u> (接地气), <u>chill</u> (放松的, 松弛的) and <u>easy-going</u> (随和的) person. I felt like I didn't need to change who I was when I was with her (我和她在一起的时候不需要改变我是谁). I felt very relaxed and <u>at ease</u> (放心) when she was around. <u>And number two</u>, she and twere very similar. We were like <u>mind-twins</u> (思想上的双胞胎), <u>on the same wavelength</u> (一个波长频道上). We really thought alike (想法相似), and we got each other's jokes (懂彼此的笑点). <u>Talking to her was like the easiest thing on earth</u> (和她聊天就像是世界上最简单的事情). <u>And finally</u>, she was a kind and generous person. She had <u>a heart of gold</u> (金子般的心). She was the kind of person that I could <u>count on</u> (我能指望得上的人).

4. 思维分层 (尤其用在最后一问,很好上手)

如果前三小问没有太多的可说的,可以在最后一问的回答上大做文章。

具体展开思路:

具体感受:细节描述内心戏,也可以讲述原因 (罗列)

例如: I felt very moved and loved when I received the gift. First, I could tell that my boyfriend must have spent a lot of

time and effort making this gift. I really appreciated his <u>romantic gesture</u>. For me, a handmade gift like this is so much better than a gift bought from the store. It's not about the <u>price tag</u>, but the <u>thought and effort he put into making me</u> <u>feel special</u> that made it the best gift ever. And then, nowadays people are losing their patience for <u>making DIY gifts</u>, because it's too <u>time-consuming</u> and <u>energy-consuming</u>. Therefore, in a time like this, my boyfriend's romantic gift seemed to be even more precious and rare.

② 具体的感受:学到了很多 (客观分析都学到了什么) (罗列)

例如: First, I learned <u>public speaking skills</u> and <u>PowerPoint slide skills</u> from her. Her PowerPoint design was simple, professional, and powerful. And her presentation skills <u>blew me away</u>. And then, I paid a lot of attention to the way she communicated with our team members. She really inspired me with her strong <u>interpersonal skills</u>. I learned how to be a better <u>communicator</u> in teamwork. And finally, I saw a lot of <u>perseverance</u> in her. She never <u>gave up on</u>

making things better and improving the quality of the outcome. She was a perfectionist (完美主义者).

③ 具体的感受:想法、状态的改变:before this experience, I thought....after this, I thought....I changed my mind. <mark>(时间分层)</mark>

例如: Before I started doing yoga, I used to be so <u>out of shape</u>(体能状态很差). I was overweight, feeling tired <u>all day long</u>, and couldn't <u>keep concentrated</u> at all. <u>My attention span was as short as a goldfish</u> and I forgot things easily...and then I started doing yoga. <u>In the beginning</u>, I <u>felt like I was in hell</u> as I was the most <u>inflexible person</u> in the world. My body was so <u>stiff</u>. But I didn't <u>throw in the towel</u>. Instead, I kept trying. And gradually I saw changes. I became better and better, and now, I'm <u>in such good shape</u>. I'm <u>physically stronger and more flexible</u>. I can <u>pull off all the yoga poses</u> without any problem. I've lost probably 15 pounds. I don't feel exhausted any more. My concentration is great. I'm not a <u>scatterbrain</u> anymore. And Yoga really can <u>lighten up my mood</u>. I feel so much lighter and brighter. I'm <u>in such a better space</u> right now. For me, yoga is magical. (时间分层)

④ 具体的感受:对未来的展望 From this experience, I realize that... I think I would... in the future. 现在想到了什么,决定未来要改

变什么 (时间分层,现在 VS 未来)

In terms of what I would normally do in that cafe, well, when I have an exam coming up, I will go there <u>on my own</u> and <u>throw myself into the task</u>. Sometimes I even spend all night there, <u>pull an all-nighter</u> and <u>hit the books</u>. This café opens

24/7, which is really good; sometimes when I'm in a social mode, I will meet up with my friends at the café, you know, just

while away the time/ kill the time, enjoy some nice coffee and kick back (放松, 扯淡).

⑥ 分群体: 有时候和 XX 人……有时候和 XX 人 (分群体)

例如: In terms of what I normally do in that cafe, well, sometimes I go there by myself, just to spend some quality time

with myself/take some "me" time. The café has an outdoor patio, sometimes I'll sit on the patio, sipping my coffee, and watching the world go by. Sometimes I visit this place with a couple of friends. We will sit at a corner, <u>catch up with each</u> other, and gossip about all kinds of things. It's our <u>favorite spot for meetups</u>.

⑦ 大众的看法,对比我的看法:

例如: As a matter of fact, she's famous for writing her love stories into her music. Some people hate it because they think

it's <u>over-sharing</u>(过度分享). I personally love it because that's just who she is. She's <u>open, down-to-earth and honest</u> like

that. I actually <u>appreciate her transparency</u>, <mark>(主流观点 VS 自己观点)</mark>

(这不就是思维分层法么?!是的!!)

【人物题】答题要点:

1. 不需要提长相(除非像是"一个好看的人"那样,和长相关系密切的主题);

2. "四转大法"是最简单的答题结构,越是没可说的时候越是要充分利用题卡。

- 3. 人物题主题细节各不相同,重复率比较高的小问分别是:
- (1) Who this person is
- (2) How you got to know this person
- *展开思路:
 - 这个人是谁,往往会在第一段开门见山就介绍,如:

Today, I'd like to talk about XXX, he/she was my classmate <u>back in university</u>/ is my cousin, and we've known each other for many years/ since forever.

- 之后,可以介绍两个人的交情,展开思路之一,如:

女生: <u>We were really close</u> back in the days. At that time, we spent every day together. We were <u>like twins/sisters</u>, <u>inseparable</u>. She was there when I was <u>pouring my eyes out</u> after a bad breakup. I was there for her when she was <u>going</u> <u>through the darkest time</u> in her life. We had an <u>amazingly strong connection/bond</u>.

男生: We were <u>like brothers</u>, <u>inseparable</u>. Tremember we spent so much time together after school, <u>shooting some hoops</u>, <u>joking/clowning around</u> on the street, <u>playing pool</u> in bars. We really <u>enjoyed each other's company</u>.

- 如果有相识的特别故事,也可以介绍一下,尤其是能突显当事人性格的细节:

We met each other in university. The first time I saw her, I saw bright colours. <u>She's the kind of person who's not afraid of</u>

<u>orange and green</u>, and the <u>colour contrast</u>(撞色) really made her <u>stand out from the crowd(鹤立鸡群)</u>.

(如果是名人,还可以介绍你当时接触其作品时的感受)

The first time when I heard Billie Eilish, I was driving my car and listening to the radio. And then suddenly her song came out. It <u>captured/grabbed my attention</u>, and <u>touched my heart</u>. I liked the beautiful melody and lyrics of the song. I <u>felt that</u> I <u>could relate to her lyrics</u>. And I liked her voice as well. Her voice is very unique, a little husky (沙哑), a little sad.

Describe a foreigner who speaks Chinese well (中文说得好的老外

You should say:

Who this person is Where this person is from How this person learns Chinese And explain why they can speak Chinese so well



with(很有趣). He is like a joker(爱开玩笑的人) with <u>endless jokes</u>. <u>He's the kind of person who can always think outside</u>

<mark>the box(想法点子很多)</mark>. He's <u>with endless ideas when it comes to</u> teaching, super <u>original</u>.

For example, in order to ignite/evoke our passion (点亮我们的热情) for English, sometimes he arranges English skits/plays

(组织英语小短剧、戏剧) for us to take part in. We all put on costumes, go on stage and perform in English. And then, he

also organizes <u>lip-sync music competitions</u>(对口型歌曲大赛). He lets us choose our favorite English songs and <u>lip-sync</u> the song. And what's more, he <u>invented a 'show and tell' section</u> in his English classes. So, basically, every time in his class, before he starts teaching, he gives 10 mins to one student to <u>go on stage</u>, and give a 10-min speech in English <u>in front</u>

• The real deal: 最好吃正宗的美味(也指某人、某物特别一流水平)

This Italian restaurant is the real deal. Their pasta tastes just like it does in Italy.

• Hit the spot: 形容好吃的食物特别令人满足,正中下怀

After a long hike, a hot bowl of soup really <u>hit the spot</u>.

• A party in your mouth: 美食的不同滋味在嘴里开 party

The blend of spices in this curry creates a real party in your mouth.

• Nurturing our souls: 滋润灵魂

Grandma's chicken soup always feels like it's <u>nurturing our souls</u>, especially when we're sick.

• Spice things up: 增加佐料,提升风味(也指在生活里给一些事情增加趣味)

Let's <u>spice things up</u> with some chili flakes to give this pasta <u>a kick</u>.

• Follow a recipe to a T: 一步一步严格跟着菜谱走

When baking a cake, it's essential to follow the recipe to a T to get the perfect result.

• Whip something up: 快速利索地准备一顿饭

I can <u>whip up</u> a delicious or elet <u>in no time</u> for a quick breakfast.

So, <u>the first person comes to my mind is my grandmother(第一个想到的是我的祖母)</u>. She has this incredible knack for(非

常有天赋于做某事) cooking and making everybody happy with her food. She's <u>the real deal</u> in the kitchen.

My grandma mainly cooks Chinese cuisines. Oh man, she has so many <u>signature dishes</u>(拿手菜): from soup(烫) to stew (炖菜), from noodles to dumplings(饺子). Her duck soup is my favorite. It is legendary(传奇的), <u>out of this world(美味</u> <u>无边际)</u>. It <u>tastes even better than those top-notch restaurants(比餐馆都好吃)</u>. <u>I'm not even kidding(我没开玩笑)</u>. (家庭第一). Cooking is <u>her way of showing love(是她展示爱的方式)</u>. I mean, when you've <u>had a long day(漫长一天过后)</u>, and you walk into her kitchen, the smell of the food will make you forget everything.

2.具体每段展开思路:

①故事也可以有背景故事, back story (to set the stage 交代背景),如:

(工作学习中的建议)I was in a "party mode" every day(每天都是派对模式), and I didn't want to put any effort into my studies.

I felt that I had a burn-out in high school when I was preparing for the <u>college entrance exam</u>(高考). So, in the first year

in university, I didn't try at all, and then my grades were terrible(分数都很糟糕) in the second year. I freaked out(吓坏了),

didn't know what to do. I felt very clueless(没有头绪) and helpless. Eventually, I <u>turned to(求助于)</u> my father for some advice.

② 万能"回忆录"口吻:

I was doing...and suddenly XXXX happened.

"One day I was walking on the street, eating my ice-crean, minding my own business, and then suddenly, a man came up to me, saying that I stole his money!"

Describe a bad service you received in a restaurant or shop (一次糟糕的服务)

You should say:

When and where it happened

What happened How it was solved And explain how you felt about the experience

So, about a year ago, my family and I had a <u>"not-so-great" experience (不是太好的经历)</u> at a <u>posh (华丽的)</u> French restaurant in our city.

It was on my mom's birthday, a day that <u>was supposed to be filled with joy</u> and celebration(本该是充满欢声笑语的一天). We

decided to <u>treat her to a special dinner(请她吃饭)</u> at a fancy French restaurant that is <u>famous on social media</u>.

When we arrived, there was a lot of people, and all the servers were very <u>occupied (很忙)</u>. We waited for about 45 mins

until finally got a table. Our server came to us, and by that time, we were still very excited and <u>in high spirits</u> (情绪很高).

But the server had this a very <u>annoyed and arrogant face(很嫌弃又傲慢的脸)</u> <u>right from the start</u>. He <u>barely greeted us</u> with a smile(几乎没有笑脸相迎), and when we asked about the specials, he just <u>shrugged(耸耸肩)</u> and said, "They change every day." <mark>素材一:</mark>

<mark>素材二:</mark>

Ok, so today I want to talk about a road trip I took with my family when I was young, which ended up with me <u>getting car</u> <u>sick (晕车)</u>.

When I was a child, my family and I went on a road trip in China during the summer. We were driving to visit my grandparents who lived in a <u>rural area (农村)</u> in China. I remember being very excited for the trip because I loved spending time with my family and exploring new places.

However, as soon as we <u>hit the road</u>, I started to feel a bit <u>queasy</u>(想吐的) / <u>nauseous</u>(恶心想吐的) / <u>funny</u>(怪怪的). At first, I <u>thought it was just a passing feeling</u>(很快会过去), but it only got worse and worse as the trip went on. I tried to distract myself by talking to my parents, playing games, and listening to music, but nothing seemed to help. The roads were winding (蜿蜒曲折) and <u>bumpy</u>(凹凸不平), and also the gasoline smell of the car made me feel terrible.

As we drove further and further away from the city and into the countryside, I began to feel worse and worse. I felt <u>dizzy</u>, <u>nauseous</u>, <u>and very uncomfortable</u>. I begged my parents to stop the car and let me out, but we were <u>in the middle of</u> <u>nowhere</u> (荒无人烟的地区) and there was nowhere to go. I tried to <u>stay calm</u>, but I was struggling to <u>keep it together (保</u>

持镇定)。

Eventually, I threw up/vomited/puked (吐) in a plastic bag in the car. It was so disgusting that my parents were even

gagging(呕吐前的作呕状,还有很多其他意思,比如笑料、使窒息) hearing me vomiting. It was <u>contagious(会传染的)</u>, I guess, haha!

Ever since then, I haven't been <u>a big fan of road trips,</u> especially those really <u>long drives</u>. <mark>I prefer to take a flight or a train</mark> 1000 times more than going on a road trip, haha<mark>! So yeah, that was the story, thank you!</mark>
