I often do it. We would freely defend our ideas and strive to convince each other, but even if we couldn't achieve the goal, there was no emotional disconnect.情感疏离

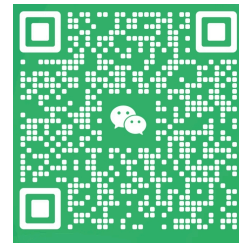
Map

I think it is an important rule not only because it enhances persistence, but also strengthens students' physical fitness.

This requirement is offensive ^{ə'fensɪv/} 让人反感的 to many students, but it has more

advantages than disadvantages.

Firstly, because of the large population and fierce competition, most students in China have to struggle with their homework till the midnight very often, so we are sick. Running can be beneficial to improving our immune system, because the process speeds up metabolism and blood circulation.

Secondly, running is also beneficial to reducing the risk of developing diseases, including obesity, colds and so on. I mean, we have to stretch our arms and legs constantly in the process of running. This can help students keep healthy.

1. **What** rules should children follow at home in your country?

Children in my country should follow rules such as respecting their elders, being polite, and helping with household chores. These rules help instill good values 培养良好的价值观 and prepare children for adulthood.

2. On **what** occasions can children be forgiven if they don't follow some rules?
