One of the reasons why Sarah is so well-liked in her community is because she is always <u>performing acts of kindness and generosity</u>, whether it's helping a neighbor with their groceries or raising money for charity

• Put the needs of others before their own 把别人的需求放在自己之前

1. Do you usually help people around you?

① Yeh, <u>I would say that, I'm a loving and compassionate person</u>/<u>I</u> <u>consider myself someone who is loving and caring</u>. And my friends and family all <u>see me as(把我视为,认为)</u> a <u>helpful person(乐于助人的人)</u>. I believe in the importance of <u>lending a helping hand</u> and supporting

<u>people in need(需要帮助的人)</u>. For me, nothing is more beautiful or powerful than <u>the acts of kindness and generosity</u>(没有什么比慷慨善良之举 更美丽或者有力量的了). (原因)

② I'm willing to help people, but not to everybody around me. I mean, I care about my family and <u>close friends</u>. So, I won't hesitate even a second to help my <u>loved ones</u> (爱的人). But <u>when it comes to</u> people who I don't have a close relationship with, sometimes, I prefer to <u>mind my own</u> <u>business</u> (顾好自己的事情) rather than <u>going out of my way to help them</u> (费劲地、特意地帮助他人). The thing is, some people tend to <u>take</u> <u>advantage of</u> (占便宜) others' kindness, which has made me more cautious (小心) about <u>offering help</u>. (分群体)

2. How do you help people around you, such neighbours, family and friends?

① For example, with my neighbors, sometimes I help them collect their <u>online shopping deliveries (代收网购包裹)</u>; sometimes I take care of their pets when they travel to somewhere. And <u>when it comes to</u> family and friends, there are so many things I would do for them, like, taking my grandparents to the hospital for <u>regular checkups</u> (定期体检); or help my friends move to a new apartment. <u>The list just goes on (列举的名单很长,还</u>有很多). (举例子)

② My way of <u>assisting</u> others doesn't necessarily involve a lot of <u>physical</u> <u>labor</u> or <u>strength</u>(我的帮助人方式不一定包含很多劳力). Instead, <u>I'm more of</u> <u>the kind of person who offers emotional support</u>(我更像是那种提供情感支持 <u>的人)</u>. For example, I'm really good at listening to people; I consider myself a <u>good listener</u>. So I'm always ready to <u>lend my friends and family</u> <u>an ear</u> (lend an ear 给一个耳朵,准备好倾听) or <u>a comforting shoulder to lean</u>

<u>on (</u>lend sb. a shoulder to lean on 给人依靠的肩膀), whenever they need someone to talk to or a place to <u>find consolation(寻找安慰).</u>(举例子)

3. Do your parents teach you how to help others?

① Yes, I would say so. I guess that's what all the parents do, right? My parents always emphasize a lot on the importance of <u>performing acts of</u> <u>kindness and generosity</u>. They <u>value(重视)</u> kindness a lot. I remember when I was a little, they always asked me to help my friends, family members and people around me. They still do today. (原因)

②Sometimes they would teach me about the concept of helping people but I don't think it's <u>on the top of their priority list(不是最优先的事情)</u>. They care much more about my <u>academic performance(学业表现)</u> at school and my future <u>career development</u>, things like that. (原因)

4. Did your parents help you a lot when you were young?

①Yes my parents are <u>the best parents in the world (世界上最好的父母)</u>. <u>They mean the whole world to me</u> (他们对我来说意味着全世界). They were <u>incredibly supportive</u> when I was growing up. They provided me with guidance, help, encouragement and they helped me <u>build my whole</u> <u>value system (建立整个价值体系)</u>. They taught me how to <u>tell right from</u> <u>wrong</u> (明辨是非). They gave me a lot of useful tools to help me <u>navigate</u> <u>through life (驾驭生活)</u>. That's why I'm forever grateful for their love and support which has <u>played a huge role</u> in <u>shaping the person I am today</u> (他们的爱和支持在塑造"如今的我" 上扮演了重要角色). (细节)

② No, not really, my parents didn't help me a lot when I was young as they were often very <u>busy with their own work and responsibilities</u>, leaving me to <u>figure out things on my own(自己把事情整明白)</u>. I guess that's why I'm so <u>independent and fearless(独立又无所畏惧)</u> now. <u>I wish I</u>

<u>had</u> parents that helped me a lot and supported me <u>no matter what</u> when I was little. (原因)

5. What have you done to help the elderly?

I remember <u>during the pandemic (疫情期间)</u>, our neighborhood was <u>distributing groceries (分发食品杂货)</u> to all the residents. Some of the elderly people who lived alone in the neighborhood had difficulty getting their <u>daily groceries</u>. So, I volunteered to bring their groceries to them every day and occasionally <u>checked in on them (查看)</u> to ensure their <u>safety and well-being (安全与健康)</u>. So yeh, these are the kind of things I do to help seniors.
