Topic 3 信息搜索

1. How can people search for information now?

1. What can children learn from parents?

Topic 7 塑料垃圾

1. What are some types of common plastic waste?/ What kinds of plastic waste are often seen in your country?

Some types of common plastic waste are food wrappers³⁴, plastic bottle caps, and plastic grocery bags. Plastic waste is very common, and very bad for the environment. It has become a bigger problem in recent years with the rise of companies like Taobao and Amazon³⁵. It's sad to see so much plastic waste in nature. 雅思过过过淘宝店铺 \ 原创

2. Do you think we should use plastic products?

I think that it's okay to use plastic products. Plastic can be very helpful and convenient, especially for reusable items³⁶ like food packaging. Plastic also makes a lot of great products like bike helmets and child safety seats. So we can use plastic products, but we should try not to use too much. Topic 8 失约

1. How do people who are busy remember things they need to do?

Most people make lists of tasks in order to remember them. A lot of people also use a calendar app. Honestly, the calendar app is very helpful. You can set reminders and your phone will alert you when the task is due⁴³. Besides, some people even have their own assistants to remind them of what they need to do. © 雅思过过过淘宝店铺

2. Do you think people should remember family history?

Yes, I think people should remember family history. Learning our family history helps honour our ancestors⁴⁴. Remembering our family history can also give us a better appreciation for our culture and community. 3. If someone doesn't really like the person that they are going to meet, they may deliberately forget their appointment; is that true? Why?

Well, it may be true for some people. Everyone deals with uncomfortable feelings differently. If you don't like a person and you want to avoid them, you may purposefully miss an appointment with them. But I don't think that helps the problem. Topic 9 收到钱作为礼物

1. Why do people rarely use cash now?

I suppose that people rarely use cash because it's more convenient to pay by card. If you use the wallet app⁴⁷ on your phone, you don't even have to carry credit cards. You can just pay for things using your phone. That's great for people who don't like carrying a lot of things around with them.

It may make them too focused on getting money. That can lead to some greedy habits⁵⁰. I think parents should reward their children with different privileges⁵¹, or even just some kind words.

Yes, it is. Learning this skill from a young age helps children develop good saving habits. This can help children become financially independent⁵². So if parents give children an allowance, they should teach them to save some of it. That way, children can have money in the future instead of just spending it all at once.

5. Do people often use credit cards? Are there issues with using credit cards?

Yes, people use credit cards very often. Instead of having to pay right away, you can put it on a credit card and pay for it later⁵³. But there can definitely be issues with using credit cards. The most common issue is identity theft and fraud⁵⁴. For example, if criminals record the information of your credit card, they can use it to make purchases.

Topic 10 糟糕的购物体验

1. What kind of customer service do you think is good?

I think that customer service should be friendly. You should be able to discuss your issue with them comfortably. Customer service should also put in a lot of effort⁵⁵. If you've had a problem with a product, it's nice to offer you a discount on your next purchase or something like that. 雅思过过过淘宝店铺

2. What are the differences between shopping online and in stores?

Shopping online gives you more options. Sometimes there are even sales that are just online. So you can end up saving money. You also save time since you don't have to go to the store. Customers often have problems with stores running out of products⁵⁷. A customer might find the perfect item for them, but the store won't have any left. That's especially a problem when shopping for clothes. Sometimes customers might have problems using coupons⁵⁸. Some people try to use coupons after they've expired. 4. What do you think customers should do when there are problems with the products they bought online?

I think customers should try to return the product and get a refund for it⁵⁹. Sometimes you can buy bad products online. But basically all online shopping platforms provide a return and refund service⁶⁰ to their customers. Topic 11 不得不与他人分享

1. Do you think kids like to share? Why?

2. How can parents teach their children to share?

Parents can teach their children to share by demonstrating it for them⁶². For example, if one parent shares something and shows that it's a positive experience, the child can then learn that sharing is good. I think sharing teaches children to be kind and generous. They can learn to consider other people's feelings.
