Honestly, I **wasn't** really prepared for how long the research process would take¹⁶. I used the university's library **database** to filter through¹⁷ **hundreds** of articles. I also went to the library in person so I could look at different scientific **journals**. Then, once I found about a **dozen** sources, I had to **read** through each of them to find **relevant** points to support my paper. It took about **one week** from start to finish¹⁸.

I **didn't** exactly love looking for the information. Although it was **exciting** to develop my **skills** as a student, it was also **tedious** to look through all those sources. Research can be a very **long** and **frustrating** process, depending on what you're looking for.

However, the research was definitely **worth** all the work. I was able to write a **strong** paper¹⁹ and receive a **good** grade. So I'm **glad** I took my time with researching²⁰.
