#### 6. Which part is difficult in your job? (高频)



I think <u>the most challenging part</u> of my job is communication within a team. It's often difficult to communicate with someone who didn't finish their part of the work in time. They may think you're <u>pushing<sup>34</sup></u> them, which can even create conflict.

#### 7. How do you spend your work day?

I usually arrive at the office before 9am and start my day with<sup>35</sup> a morning meeting with my boss and co-workers, which really helps me and others know the agenda of the day<sup>36</sup> as well as keep everyone on the same page<sup>37</sup>. Then the long day of work begins and I need to work overtime until  $\underline{8pm^{38}}$  most days.

#### 8. Is it better to work in the morning or in the afternoon?

I think it's better to work in the morning. Even though you have to wake up early, when you <u>get</u> <u>through the work<sup>39</sup></u> you have the rest of the day off. And the afternoon is usually a better time of day to enjoy yourself. So it's best to <u>get work over with<sup>40</sup></u> as early as possible.

## 9. Have you ever changed your job? / Why did you choose to do that type of job?

I've changed my job <u>a couple times</u>. Before working at this company, I had full-time jobs at an IT company and a glass shop. But neither of them is bigger than the company I'm working for right now <u>in terms of business scale</u>. And most importantly, I get paid more for my current job, which is the main reason I job-hopped<sup>41</sup>.

Well...<u>As far as I'm concerned</u>, I really wish my company wasn't so strict about the <u>dress code<sup>51</sup></u>. <u>It</u> really bugs me<sup>52</sup> to have to wear a uniform <u>day in and day out<sup>53</sup></u>. Plus, I have to be really careful keeping the uniform clean otherwise I might <u>get fined<sup>54</sup></u> at my workplace. It would be great if we could <u>have a casual Friday<sup>55</sup></u>.

# 14. Is this job a good opportunity? / Is it good for your future development?

Yes, it's a wonderful job. Even though <u>I'm swamped with<sup>56</sup></u> the tasks at work sometimes and have to <u>work overtime<sup>57</sup></u>, overall, I believe it's a good career for me. I'm very <u>passionate about<sup>58</sup></u> my job and I really know what to do. Plus, doing this job right now will definitely help me <u>build my resume<sup>59</sup></u> later, since it requires excellent workmanship.

They should play outside more or hang out with their friends. That's the best way to spend your childhood<sup>281</sup>. Too much TV can make kids lazy.

## 4. What about the current TV programs do you think could be improved? (高频)

I think that current TV programs should be more educational. <u>I don't mean that<sup>282</sup></u> they should feel like a lecture. But they should be focused on more serious things. There are <u>way too many reality TV</u> shows<sup>283</sup>. Those shows are <u>a total waste of time and resources<sup>284</sup></u>.
