Topic 1 Study¹(含 school)(建议重点复习高频题;工作族可以不复习该主题)

1. Do you work or study?(高频)

I'm currently a senior student at Hunan University, and I'm studying computer science at the moment.

2. What's your routine like in your everyday study? /What's your daily study routine? (高频)

I try to wake up <u>at a decent time²</u> in the morning. If I don't have class, I spend the morning <u>organizing</u> <u>my notes from the day before³</u>. I also like going to a café with my friends to <u>go over our study</u> <u>materials⁴</u>. In the evening, I'll go over my notes in more detail and memorize important information.

3. Is it difficult for you to organize your time to study? (高频)

Sometimes it can be hard. When I have a lot of tasks to do, it's difficult to decide which ones to do first. I can <u>get overwhelmed⁵</u> and feel like I don't have enough time. But it's helpful to list everything and <u>organize my time based on importance and urgency⁶</u>.

6. How do you usually spend your school day? (高频)

I usually spend my school day with a combination of¹⁰ homework, class, and spending time with friends. I also sometimes like to participate in a club or other <u>extracurricular activity¹¹</u> during lunch or after school. Most of my day I spend doing schoolwork because I don't want to <u>fall behind¹²</u>.

7. What technology can help you learn better? (高频)

There are lots of websites and apps that can quiz you and test your knowledge. All you have to do is <u>input your terms¹³</u> and then you can use <u>online flashcards¹⁴</u>. I've used a couple of them to memorize important terms before an exam. They're definitely <u>a life-saver¹⁵</u> when you're <u>in a rush to catch up</u> <u>on¹⁶</u> some class content.

8. Why did you choose your school / university?

Well, when I was a high school student, I heard my university has a really good undergraduate program for Computer Science¹⁷, which is really what <u>I'm passionate about</u> and love to study. Besides, my parents also <u>rooted for¹⁸</u> me to go there as they believe four years of study there would be <u>a big help for my future career</u>.

9. Is it good to study in the morning or in the afternoon? / Do you prefer to study in the morning or in the afternoon?

14. Which part do you hope your school to change? /Which part of your school needs an improvement?

Well, <u>off the top of my head</u>, the <u>most urgent part</u> of my school that needs to be improved is the gym on our campus. I mean, <u>the whole place should be flipped²⁶</u> because everything in the gym is literally <u>worn out²⁷</u>. The basketball court doesn't even have a <u>hoop</u>. It's <u>ridiculous</u>, isn't it? I really hope our school can do something about it.

15. Are you looking forward to working?

Yes, I am. I've been studying as a student for almost 16 years of my life. I really expect to have a proper job after graduating from college. 1. Do you work or study? What work do you do? (高频)

I'm <u>currently</u> working fulltime as a programmer at Baidu; <u>I've been working there for</u> 5 years.

2. Do you like your job? (高频)

Yes, I am really happy with what I do. Most of the time, <u>it's very rewarding to</u> be able to help people every day. Besides, it's a really good company to work for. The pay is good and they even <u>hand out</u> <u>bonuses³¹</u> twice a year!

3. Do your coworkers help you at work? Who is the most helpful co-worker? (高频)

I <u>work for an IT company as a HR specialist³²</u>, so I often need my coworkers to help me with the group tasks. When I was new at the job, my co-worker Penny was really helpful. She often reminded me how to process the files. She also <u>worked on³³</u> hiring tasks with me. I'm so grateful to her because she taught me everything I know.

4. How do you manage your time when working? (高频)

6. What technologies do you often use at work? (高频)

I don't use anything <u>super complex³⁹</u> at work. There's an online application that we use to chat with each other. But it's not difficult to use. <u>I'm not a tech wizard by any means⁴⁰</u>. I just use <u>standard</u> <u>word-processors⁴¹</u> and other typical office software. Most of my job involves phone calls and emails. <u>It's nothing fancy⁴²</u>.

7. What is the most interesting part of your job?

I work at a coffee shop, so I think the most interesting part of my job is the people. I get to meet so many people <u>during my shift⁴³</u>. Some of them have fascinating personalities. Sometimes I even <u>strike</u> <u>up a chat with⁴⁴</u> them and <u>learn something random</u>. One time a customer showed me photos of his cat.

8. Which part is difficult in your job?

I think <u>the most challenging part</u> of my job is communication within a team. It's often difficult to communicate with someone who didn't finish their part of the work in time. They may think you're <u>pushing⁴⁵</u> them, which can even create conflict.

9. How do you spend your work day?

I usually arrive at the office before 9am and <u>start my day with⁴⁶</u> a morning meeting with my boss and co-workers, which really helps me and others know <u>the agenda of the day⁴⁷</u> as well as <u>keep everyone</u> <u>on the same page⁴⁸</u>. Then the long day of work begins and I need to <u>work overtime until 8pm⁴⁹</u> most days.

10. Is it better to work in the morning or in the afternoon?

I think it's better to work in the morning. Even though you have to wake up early, when you <u>get</u> <u>through the work⁵⁰</u> you have the rest of the day off. And the afternoon is usually a better time of day to enjoy yourself. So it's best to <u>get work over with⁵¹</u> as early as possible.

11. Have you ever changed your job? / Why did you choose to do that type of job?

I've changed my job <u>a couple times</u>. Before working at this company, I had full-time jobs at an IT company and a glass shop. And most importantly, I get paid more for my current job, which is the main reason I job-hopped⁵².

12. What did you gain the most from your job? /What do you learn from work?

Well...The most valuable lesson I learned from work is how to <u>collaborate with⁵³</u> my coworkers. It's not something that I really understood back in school. But in a real job, a ton of tasks need good teamwork and can't be done <u>on your own</u>. For instance, when I coordinated a marketing event with my colleagues, <u>it was of the essence to⁵⁴ make sure everyone was on the same page⁵⁵</u>, or else we might've <u>messed up⁵⁶</u> the whole thing.

13. Which do you think is more important, colleagues or work itself?

I think that colleagues are more important. You could be <u>doing your dream job</u>, but if it's with <u>people</u> <u>you can't stand⁵⁷</u>, you aren't going to enjoy it <u>as much</u>. You <u>end up seeing your coworkers more than</u> <u>anyone else in your life⁵⁸</u>, so it's important that you can get along with them.

14. What do you do to improve your productivity?

Whenever I feel like I've lost focus on work and started <u>slacking⁵⁹</u>, I <u>take a 5-minute break</u> and make a cup of instant coffee. It sounds simple but <u>it works like a charm for me⁶⁰</u>. After I've had some coffee, I feel <u>pumped up⁶¹</u> and have more energy.

I'm very <u>passionate about⁶⁹</u> my job and I really know what to do. Plus, doing this job right now will definitely help me <u>build my resume⁷⁰</u> later, since it requires excellent workmanship.

17. Do you miss being a student?

No, I don't really miss being a student. It was fun to study something that I liked. But <u>it was also a</u> <u>lot of work⁷¹</u>. Going to school isn't exactly <u>a piece of cake⁷²</u>. There were <u>tons of</u> assignments and exams to do. I like being more independent now that I've graduated.
