4. 文中黄色高亮的内容，是高分地道表达；加粗内容则是建议重读的地方；
5. 所有口语题目均为多次核实确定的考题，接下来我们仍将继续跟进核实，如有需补充题目或有需要更新的资料，会及时补充添加至“补充更新文件夹”。您在复习中有对题目的疑问，也欢迎随时联系 Penny 解答；
6. Part2 题目四小问有参考考生回忆和雅思哥来写。但请注意，Part2 题卡四小问是在考场上引导考生现场组织答案用的，不是必须回答的。你如果在准备 Part2 过程中，有自己想说的内容，不必在意是否和四小问内容完全一致，只要和主 Topic 相关即可；

I'm going to talk about a song called "**Papaoutai**." The title is in **French**, and it translates to "**Dad, where are you?**" Once you learn more about the **story** of the song, it's actually quite **sad**.

I first found this song a few **years** ago, **back when I was** trying to **learn** French. I wanted to listen to some French **music**, which is how I **found** this song. It's by a **Belgian** musician who **goes by the name**⁶² **Stromae**. The song is really **upbeat**⁶³, and if you **didn't** know the words, you'd think it was **fun** and **happy**.

But when I **looked up the lyrics** and **translated** them, I realized it's actually pretty **depressing**. The song tells the story of a **boy** who lives with his **mother**.
