I worked **part-time** at a grocery store and bakery throughout university, and I was about **18** when I first started working. I remember my first day of **training** like it was yesterday⁶¹, because I was **nervous** about it. I was so **scared** of making a mistake. I learned a **lot** of lessons on the first day, but the one that **stuck** with me⁶² is when I learned how to make a **cappuccino**.

At the **bakery**, I had many **different** responsibilities⁶³. I remember this lesson because learning to make proper **specialty coffees**⁶⁵ is a skill that I have used **all** my life. I eventually got my **own** espresso machine and made coffees at **home**, just like I **used to** at work. Although at the time I felt **frustrated** and **hopeless**, I'm so glad that I **persevered** and was able to **perfect** my skills⁶⁶. 11. 有趣的歌曲

When it comes to an **interesting** song, the first one that **comes to mind** is "**Viva la Vida**" by **Coldplay**, which is a British **rock** band. If memory serves correctly, the song came out in **2008**. It was a **huge** hit⁶⁷ that year. There are **lots** of layers to the song⁶⁸ that make it really **captivating**.

The title actually means "**Long Live Life**" in Spanish. Basically, the song tells the story of a **king** who's **lost** his kingdom. He's singing about losing his place in **life** and how the **best** days of his life have passed. He mentions how even though he had so much **status**, it **didn't** really matter. It sounds really **depressing**, but it actually makes some **good** points⁶⁹. The lyrics point out how you can't become obsessed with **material** things⁷⁰. In the end, we're all just **human beings** who have to deal with our **emotions** and focus on what's really **important**.

Like I mentioned⁷¹, the song was **really** popular. It's one of Coldplay's **best-known** songs. Even though it's been **years** since it came out, I can still remember **every word** when I hear it on the radio. They still play it at their **concerts**, even though it's around **fourteen** years old. I think the song is so popular because even though it's really **moody**⁷², it makes people think about what they **value** in life. That's why it's **interesting**. Plus, the melody is really **catchy**⁷³. It just gets **stuck** in your head⁷⁴.

12. 帮助学习语言的工具

One tool that helped me learn a language is the <u>Bescherelle⁷⁵</u> that I used when learning French. Originally, Bescherelle was a book of verb conjugations⁷⁶, but nowadays there is a website and even an **app**. As a tool, Bescherelle is very **useful** for helping people **perfect** their French verb conjugations⁷⁷ and **expand** their skillset. I used it in combination with⁷⁸ a **dictionary** the entire time I was learning French, and I recommend it to my **friends** to use as well.

When learning a **new** language, I find that it is really **important** to have my **different** strategies and tools at your disposal⁷⁹. The Bescherelle was one of my **favourite** tools because it took my **writing** and **grammar** skills to the next level; without it, I would have probably **never** progressed very much in my French language learning. Verb conjugations are really **difficult** to learn, especially in French because they have so many **irregular** verbs⁸⁰ that do not follow the usual grammar rules. With the Bescherelle, I never had to **guess** what the correct verb conjugation should be.

I felt very **relieved** when I figured out **how** to use the Bescherelle and understood how **easy** it was. It helped me for **years**, and I think I would have had a much more **difficult** time learning the language **without** it. **Not** everyone is cut out to⁸¹ learn **another** language, but for the few that **are**⁸², finding the **right** tools is absolutely crucial.
