新增小题 Topic 1 Study(含 school)(建议重点复习高频题;工作族可以不复习该主题)

1. Do you sometimes feel that you have to study too hard? (高频)

Yeah, I've had that feeling before. <u>My program can be very demanding</u>¹. It definitely takes up a lot of my time. And I find that I don't always get the grade that I want. So I <u>put in hours and hours of</u> work to try and do better. It can be really exhausting. Sometimes I wonder if it's worth it.
