一、 雅思口语主要误区

雅思考试的误区,我们来通过做真题来感受一下,认识上的错误。

① 误解一 (Memorizing the script in large chunks before the exam) :

认为雅思口语考试就是背素材大比拼。于是: 狂背素材,考场上疯狂输出,不求甚解,浮于表面

<mark>结果反被扣分惩罚</mark>(往往6分以下),因为不是真实水平的体现(所谓的"压分")

② 误解二 (Translating everything from Chinese to English)

把想到的中文内容,机械翻译成英文。导致:逻辑不通,表达不地道,<mark>照样低分</mark>

- 怎么办: 输入→输出。
- 要学会用 思维 迁就 语言水平。"所说即所想"。
- 从今天起,只说自己会说的,而不是去说自己想说的。"打好手里的牌"。
 (把整套课程的语料消化掉一半都足够支撑口语考试)

3 误解三:

认为考试时回答"是"和"否"就行,一两个词干巴巴地打发考官,而且认为必须"就事论事",不能编 内容。 <u>你需要在自然的、顺应语境的前提下</u>,稍微延展一些内容。给考官更多机会打分。当内容太 复杂的时候,也要学会简化内容,增强可理解性。

- 怎么办: 输入>输出。学习如何收放自如地说话。
- Where is your favourite place to meet with your friends?
- 误解一回答:

Well, talking about a place to meet with friends, it is very essential for people to spend time with their friends in order to strengthen ties. Meeting with friends can relive stress and increase people's mood. Therefore, it is very essential to visit friends every once in a while. And I'm no exception. When it comes to my favourite place to

meet with my friends, it is at school.

- Part 1 大部分情况下是在问"你",扯远了算跑题。考官不耐烦的原因之一。
- 说了半天也没提到的具体内容,迟迟不肯开始答题
- 华丽而不接地气的表达,把自己掌握的最"高大上"的书面表达生硬地堆砌在一起。

比如 strengthen ties 一般只有在形容国家、合作机构、战略伙伴之间,才用到(bond with)

• 误解二回答:

KTV 怎么说? 电玩中心怎么说?

I like meeting my friends at KTV...and...piu piu piu center.

Karaoke bar; arcade center

- 打好手里的牌,考试时候会说什么就说什么
- 转述的意识 paraphrasing

比如,The book was thought-provoking 不会说,改成 The book made me think a lot.

• 误解三回答:

I meet my friends at parks very often. I like parks.

还是要说一些可以展示语言水平的表达。

更好版本的回答(参考):

(1) My favourite place to <u>meet up</u> with my friends is this park in my city called Yuyuan

Tan. It's a place where we can <u>take a walk</u> together, <u>get some sun(晒晒太阳),</u> and <u>get</u>

<u>some fresh air(透透气)</u>. It's such a peaceful place that helps us <u>blow off the steam</u>, <u>get away from the hustle and bustle(远离喧嚣)</u>, and also we can <u>have a nice heart-</u> <u>to-heart conversation(来一场心贴心的对话)</u>. It's <u>my favourite spot</u> to <u>meet up</u>. (原因, 细节)

喜欢这个公园的原因,以及细节性描述。

可以同时回答以下几个问题("通用型语料"的积累):

- Where is your favourite place to sit? (p1 Sitting down)
- What kinds of things are boring to you? (p1 boring things)
- What sports do you like? (p1 doing sports)

(2) I love meeting up with my friends at Hou Hai. It's an area in Beijing. This place is

full of relaxing <u>dive bars</u>(慢摇酒吧)and quiet <u>hole-in-the-wall restaurants</u>(很小的不 好找的低调的小馆儿). <u>Night life</u> in this area is mainly about <u>outdoor beers</u> and <u>street</u> <u>food</u>, and <u>accompanied by/with live music</u>(伴有很多现场音乐). It's the perfect place

to <u>chill out</u> with some friends. (原因,细节)

A. 素材怎么学(以上题素材为例):

<mark>第一步:总结素材里实用的表达(拿到更多牌)</mark>

1. 关于"放松"的表达: blow off the steam, get away from the hustle and bustle, chill out

2. 关于"休闲娱乐"的表达: take a walk, get some sun, get some fresh air, have a nice (heart-to-heart) conversation, dive bars, hole-in-the-wall, night life, outdoor beer,

street food, live music

- 3. 动词和名词搭配: GET some sun, GET some fresh air, HAVE a conversation,
- 4. 地道且"小众"(less common)的表达: heart-to-heart, spot, hole-in-the-wall
- 5. 介词使用: meet up with

<mark>第二步:内化。通过造句练习,自言自语,开练!</mark>

- 1. 针对"单词、词组"进行内化练习: 例如 chill out, blow off the steam, hole-in-the-wall, ... (看着这些词组片段,脑海中想象着画面)
 - 你说: I've been so busy lately. I <u>feel swamped</u> and <u>stuck in my life</u>. Sometimes

I force myself to go to the gym, to blow off the steam and chill out a little.

• 你又说:I really need to <u>chill out</u>. I've been working non-stop for hours.

增加对单词、词组运用的灵活性,做到举一反三。

2. 针对"句型"进行内化练习:例如"It's a place where we can <u>take a walk</u> together, <u>get</u>

<u>some sun(晒晒太阳),</u> and <u>get some fresh air(透透气)</u>.

- 你说: This café is a place where people can have a delicious cup of coffee, listen to the music and have a heart-to-heart conversation with their friends.

...<u>relieve stress(中国学生最爱用的)</u> It's indeed a stress reliever.

- Do you want to learn more about art?

① For sure. I always want to learn more about art even though <u>I don't know much</u> <u>about it.</u> Still, being knowledgeable about art is <u>a very cool thing.</u> You can understand and enjoy art <u>in a better way</u>, you can talk about art and make more art friends. <u>It's always a good thing to know more about art</u>. (原因)

2 Always! There're always new things to learn about art. It never ends. Stay humble,

stay foolish. <u>That's my motto</u>(人生名言). As an <u>art lover</u>, I'll always be curious about

I still remember how my primary school art teacher taught us how to draw all kind of animals, a lion, a tiger, a horse, and a dog. Everybody learned drawing when they were kids, no matter it was <u>inschool art classes</u> or <u>extra-curricular classes</u> (课外班). (细节)

今日总结

短期内提分的本质是什么? 通俗来讲:

<u>说话逻辑合理、思维切题,针对话题有地道表达。能说人话。Easier said than done</u>

① 话题语料的收集,减少口语表达的盲区。

② 针对话题的观点+输出观点时的逻辑框架;

③ 思维降级的意识,用思维去迁就语言。打好手里现有的牌,而不是去创造语言。(整套课提供了大量的简单表达,你需要细心收集,学会借鉴如何化繁为简,内化+模仿。学会举一反三,灵活出牌);
 ④ 练习的部分必不可少。

整套课程直播+录播<u>反复观看</u>之后,如何拿着素材练习? (直播+直播录像+录播赠课+公开课录像看 完之后)

A. 理解基础上,参照思路和语料,局部背诵(固定搭配)+局部脱稿 现场组织语言。前期可以写关 键词

B. 实在做不到 A,可以背,但请尝试改变每段话的语序,以此来加强印象和理解
