No one knows when the first map was made. Perhaps it was some paleolithic hunter scratching lines in the earth to direct his comrades to where he had seen prey. The oldest surviving physical object which could be called a map is a wall painting of a town plan at the archeological site in Anatolia, Turkey. Radiocarbon examination dates it from about 6200 B.C. Maps are known from classical times —a clay tablet with a city plan from Mesopotamia; a world map on bronze supposedly shown to the King of Sparta circa

500 B.C.; an Egyptian papyrus showing a gold
