The use of ambergris in urope is now entirely confined to perfumeryas a materia标 of perfumery. Its high price varies from 1 to an ounce, though it formerly occupied on inconsiderable place in medicine. Ambergris was also decorated and worn as jewelry, particularly during the Renaissance. It occupies a very important place in the perfumery of the East, and there it is also used in pharmacy, and as a flavouring material in cookery.
