digitization. With the development of computer technology, people can search the knowledge what they want to acquire via database and read e-books by electronic devices. So, it is assumed that the public library would be no longer a church sacred to knowledge. Moreover, viewed from the angle of economics, funding public libraries is not wise. As most public libraries are free to all but need a vast amount of money for maintenance, taxpayers, who provide state funds, think that libraries cannot bring any economic return. Therefore, some of them do not approve of funding libraries.

On the one hand, public usage of libraries is much lower than the past due to the development of

On the other hand, the value of public libraries in popularizing education cannot be underestimated. Libraries, as is pervasively known, provide a fair access for the public to gain knowledge and skills regardless of how old they are, how much they earn and whether they are educated or not. To some extent, libraries are like the land of opportunity, where anyone can become educated and can realize their dream of personal success. In addition, public libraries contain a wide range of materials available to readers. Not all the books can be digitized particularly those old books, and a variety of audiovisual materials can also be borrowed for free. Thus, their existence is of necessity.

For computers to function properly, humans will be needed to check work, improve it and manage it. It is predicted that the new positions will require additional skills for managing the interface between technology and humans. Therefore, computers can promote human progress.

For example, an Israeli company called 'Prospera' has developed a system that uses a machine learning system that can identify signs of insect damage in plant images as well as analyze plant nutrition data, weather forecasts, and other data to predict if a particular plant is at risk of becoming sick, which can positively contribute to agriculture. Therefore, it is worthwhile to enhance computer technology.

They charge a nominal entrance fee in the neighborhood of \$20 a ticket and invest that money wisely to ensure a memorable experience for all museum-goers.

A contrasting example with MoMA would be a museum just a few blocks away: The Metropolitan Museum of Art. The MET has educated and uplifted millions of citizens regardless of their socioeconomic status. The wealthy who can afford museum admission are likely to already have a deep appreciation of the arts as well as the leisure time to enjoy their practice. People, and children especially, from poorer backgrounds have fewer opportunities, so free museums is the best way to support appreciation of the arts.

- <u>General education courses can be valuable to individual career.</u> That's because no job, no matter how specialized, is removed from the larger world. For example, a person who has acquired the knowledge about geography, physics, and chemistry can become a qualified barista who can identify the qualities of coffee beans planted in different regions and know how to roast beans properly.
- <u>Another advantage is that receiving a general education can improve critical thinking.</u> Not only are most general education courses geared toward analyzing, evaluating, and synthesizing information, but the wide breadth of knowledge you can gain in your general education courses will expand your overall understanding of the world and give you more knowledge to work with when applying critical thinking skills later. For example, when evaluating a marketing case, the students receiving general education can take manifold factors into account, including the political aspect, the cultural perspective, and the economic factor.

By working together with peers whose personalities differ from each other, youngsters can learn how to communicate with others, how to handle misunderstanding as well as how to provide support to others. The spirit of cooperation is crucial in the workplace where teamwork is not uncommon. In addition, competition may result in rivalry feeling for the peer group and others. These rivalry feelings take no time in turning into jealous and personal grudges. A heart full of jealousy for others can never hold good for themselves and for others.

BP2: On the other hand, universities also benefit the nation by creating educated societies. the young can build independent thinking through university education, who can contribute towards social innovation by their expertise. Many scientific inventions are developed in university laboratories which

have been widely applied in various fields ranging from agriculture to space research. Thus, one main function of university education is to boost national economy.

Nurture, not nature, is responsible for antisocial behaviors. That is to say, everybody is born with good personalities and what turns some into criminals is lack of education. Many studies have shown that children who are not supervised and educated by their parents on a regular basis are many times more likely to go off the rails because they do not know how to distinguish right from wrong and what actions are illegal. Therefore, with moral education provided during the imprisonment, the number of people who recommit crimes would decline.

<u>Education can enable those ex-convicts to become employable.</u> while being in jail, inmates have plenty of time which can be misspent. For example, some of them spend their time gambling with their inmates or accessing materials with indecent contents. Thus, equipping them with job skills and techniques which are required for certain occupations like how to fix cars can make a difference.

<u>Nevertheless, there are objections to this perspective.</u> Those who oppose it, claim that the potential program of giving education to criminals can cost a huge amount of money from the government budget. <u>However,</u> considering the result it can deliver in the long run as far as societal stability is concerned, this program is not a waste of taxpayers' money.

On the one hand, it is believed that individuals need to live simple lives and rely less on technology. The first suggestion is that people should walk or cycle rather than drive cars. However, to decide whether to buy advertised items or not is ultimately a subjective issue. Even if some people may choose those trendy clothes or accessories, what enables them to make buying decisions is not only the consideration about whether the items are in fashion or not but also whether they are suitable to them or not, like whether a beanie hat is suited to their face shape. Therefore, advertising is not the main reason.)

In addition, there are a variety of advertisements that provide consumers a wide selection of items. In the context of commercial competitions, the items in the same category are different in brands, styles and functions, and the potential consumers they target vary from each other. For example, the brand ' Zara' is promoted as a symbol of fashion among the young, while the brand 'Muji' is advertised as a representation of the simplicity of life. So, advertisements do not make people indistinguishable from each other. 11.As well as making money, businesses also have a responsibility towards society.To what extent do you agree or disagree?

Indeed, for businesses, it is justifiable that profitability is given as the priority. If a company is unable to pay its bills or meet the changing needs of customers, any concerns about social responsibilities become irrelevant. In other words, a company can only make a positive contribution to society if it is in good financial health. Therefore, it must guarantee its work productivity first.

However, Large and small businesses are no different from individuals and have the same obligation to be ethical. Every business, conducting themselves in a just manner, will contribute greatly to the betterment of society. A local grocery shop that pays its workers a living wage, charges fair prices, keeps accurate books, and sells quality food taken in the aggregate with stores around the country, produces innumerable benefits for both staff and patrons. Large companies are no exception. If Apple pays employees well and builds quality products while adhering to environmental and economic regulations, they make the world a better place. After all, companies have the influential power on changing the life of the general public.

Moreover, a socially-responsible company can gain long-term economic benefits. If an organization doesn't look toward waste reduction, clean water programs, or other environmentally-friendly opportunities, they are missing out on the entire market group of consumers who prefer to buy from socially responsible and sustainable companies that align with their values. This translates to lost revenue.

个人立场: wealthy nations should provide aids and need to make sure the aids are properly used.

On the one hand, rich nations aiding the underdeveloped countries is morally right. our common humanity means that those who are doing well should help those whose basic needs are not met. Given that people living in impoverished areas are still suffering from the crisis of survival like starvation, the

spread of infectious diseases as well as water shortage, the wealthy countries where resources are rich and technology is advanced can and should provide humanitarian aids. After all, each one deserves the right to live.

On the other hand, some may argue that much of the 'help' does not help. By trying to help poor people in developing countries, the rich world may be corrupting those nations' governments and slowing their growth. For some rich countries, those backward areas are merely the hub of manufacturing. They give aids to the poor in the hope of exploiting the resources or using cheap labor force. As a result, the situation in underdeveloped areas might become worse.

<u>Nevertheless</u>, I still believe that wealthy countries should aid the poor areas. In order to make sure the proper use of aids, the intervention of the United Nations and other world organizations is necessary which can ensure fair and neutral distribution.

To some extent, cultural assimilation may pose a risk to the preservation of cultural heritages belonging to the wealth of all humans. Therefore, this is why a Little Italy and China towns can be found and gain high popularity in many places.

On the one hand, the state funds should be distributed to the aspects aiming to deal with substantial living problems facing human beings. poverty, disease, violence, environmental pollution, and more are constantly plaguing humanity, and even our best efforts far cannot address all of everybody's needs. Governments should prioritize humanitarian needs. Why study the resources on other planets when air pollution existing on Earth is still becoming severe? Thus, if individual suffering is not solved, it is not wise for the government to fund the research on other planets.

On the other hand, investing in exploring other planets is investing in the betterment of humanity. The result of space exploration is not only fantastic scientific discoveries, but also many useful inventions which have impacted our daily lives in more ways than most people imagine, from helping to improve artificial limbs to using lasers developed for monitoring gases in the atmosphere for heart surgery. Thus, we should not be shortsighted when evaluating the importance of doing space research.

If they purchase goods, about 10 percent of the bill will go to the government. As a result, the government can also provide good facilities such as proper roads and safety to citizens. That is why most of the metropolitan cities encourage shopping malls and stores to increase their revenue.

<u>However, this would lead to consumerism which should not be advocated</u>. this negative trend adopted by young people is forcing themselves to spend extravagantly while they got out for shopping.
