Without any clues like audiovisual demonstrations, a kid reading a fairy tale with illustration can feel free to think, fantasize the plots and use their creativity to comprehend the underlying meanings behind the story, which can in turn positively contribute to their mental abilities. However, watching TV or playing computer games might restrict their imagination since all the scenes are directly shown to them. Thus, educationalists still advocate more reading and less reliance on TV and computers.





主体段落二: Nevertheless, when it comes to children's intellectual development, watching TV or playing computer games can also bring positive effects. With vivid pictures and animations, children can be inspired and motivated to watch a variety of TV programs which can enable them to acquire a wide range of knowledge in a simple way.
