The first successful method for making clear, flat glass involved spinning. This method was very effective as the glass had not touched any surfaces between being soft and becoming hard, so it stayed perfectly unblemished, with a 'fire finish'. However, the process took a long time and was labour intensive.

A corpus enables the linguist to make unbiased statements about <u>frequency of usage</u>, and it provides accessible data for the use of different researchers. Its range and size are variable. Some corpora attempt to cover the language as a whole, taking extracts from many kinds of text; others are extremely selective, providing a collection of material that deals only with a <u>particular linguistic feature</u>.

Sometimes a small sample of data will be enough to decide a linguistic hypothesis; by contrast, corpora in major research projects can total millions of words. An important principle is that all corpora, what-ever their size, are inevitably limited in their coverage, and always need to be supplemented by data derived from the <u>intuitions</u> of native speakers of the language, through either introspection or experimentation.

James Boswell, his biographer, described the garret where Johnson worked as 'fitted

up like a counting house' with a long desk running down the middle at which the <u>copying</u> <u>clerks</u> would work standing up.

The work was immense; filling about eighty large notebooks (and without a <u>library</u> to hand), Johnson wrote the definitions of over 40,000 words,...

On publication, the Dictionary was immediately hailed in many European countries as a landmark. According to his biographer, James Boswell, Johnson's principal achievement was to bring 6 to the English language. As a reward for his hard work, he was granted a 7 by the king.

It is the cornerstone of Standard English, an achievement which, in James Boswell's

words, 'conferred stability on the language of his country'.

The Dictionary, together with his other writing, made Johnson famous and so well esteemed that his friends were able to prevail upon King George III to offer him a pension. From then on, he was to become the Johnson of folklore.
