主语一样 连词 主语 岛 动词原形 +ing

He stood there waiting for the bus.

He stood there and he waited for the bus.

Kate is in the kitchen and she is making coffee.

→ Kate is in the kitchen making coffee.

■ doing 原因

主语一样 连词 主语 典式 动词原形 +ing

Because I felt tired, I went to bed early.

= Feeling tired, I went to bed early.

Being so angry, he could not go to sleep.

Because he was so angry, he could not go to sleep.

■ doing 原因

- = Not knowing his address, I cannot write him.
- Because I do <u>not</u> know his address, I cannot write him.

- I stood there awkwardly, as I didn't know what to say.
- = I stood there awkwardly, not knowing what to say.
 - doing 原因

■ doing 时间/当·····的时候

= Joe hurt his knee playing football.

Joe hurt his knee while he was playing football.

= Did you cut yourself shaving?
Did you cut yourself while you were shaving?

It is hard to define happiness = Happiness is hard to define

Another person might find happiness in sports and others in other things.

Because we all have different personalities and hobbies, it only makes sense that we define happiness in different ways.

When I have good friends I can rely on and people around me who understand me and are loyal to me, I feel happy.





It is hard to be happy <u>when alone</u>, so I value my friendships

and work hard at them so that when I am feeling down,

I know I have the support I need.













So as a conjunction

We use so as a subordinating conjunction to introduce clauses of result or decision:

I got here late. It was a long journey, **so** I'm really tired now.

You are right, of course, **so** I think we will accept what the bank offers.

It's much cheaper with that airline, isn't it, **so**I'll get all the tickets for us with them.

So and that-clauses

We use so + that as a conjunction to introduce clauses of reason and explanation:

They both went on a diet **so that** they could play more football with their friends.





Another aspect of happiness for me is

having work that is meaningful and rewarding.

Let me be clear about this:

I am not talking about how much money a person makes.

That is not real happiness.

What I am talking about is being able to use one's skills

and feel that one is making a difference.

This is a source of real happiness for me.





To conclude, happiness is a state of being that each of us defines.

We do not need to worry about comparing ourselves to others.

That only leads to disappointment. Happiness is in our own hands.
