- I don't know you are an expert at Marxism.
- I didn't know you are an expert at Marxism.



#### (三)、现在完成时:

# I、表示过去发生的动作,一直持续到现在。 e.g. Up to now, I <u>have studied</u> English for 8 years.

(四)、过去完成时:

表示在过去的某个动作之前,发生的动作,即"过去的过去",通常用来比较,常跟一般过去时连用,但跟距离现在的远近无关。

e.g.

 Before XM <u>went</u> to America 3 years ago, he <u>had lived</u> in China for 18 years.

 例外: 固定搭配

- There is <u>a rat</u> in Tom's car.
- Here comes <u>a bus</u>.
- adj. / adv. / 介宾都不能做主语。

e.g.

• (On the desk) is an OG.

- not only A but also <u>B</u> + Verb
- neither A nor <u>B</u> + Verb

• either A or <u>B</u> + Verb



- <u>A and B</u> +are
- A house and a wife are necessary.
- Money and a wife are necessary.
- Water and air are necessary.
- **例外**:当<u>A and B</u>是一个东西 + is

- <u>A poet and writer</u> + is
- <u>The Old Man and The Sea +is</u>
