## 第四讲 非谓语动词

一、基本用法

• 1.不定式

作用:可以做除谓语以外的各种成分。
 (主、宾、表、定、状等。)

e.g.<u>To see</u> is <u>to believe</u>. 主 表

- (一)概念:
  - 位于句首的doing / done的动作发出者或接受者,即为它的逻辑主语,逻辑主语等于主句主语。
- (二) 形式:
- I <u>Doing / Done</u>, SV O.
- Beating Tom black and blue, Jerry is happy.
- Beaten black and blue, Tom is crying.
- 2 <u>prep + doing</u>, SV O.
- 3 <u>adj. + prep + n.</u> SV O. (<u>(Being) adj. + prep + n.</u> SV O)
   e.g. Famous throughout the world, Confucius was a great teacher.
