

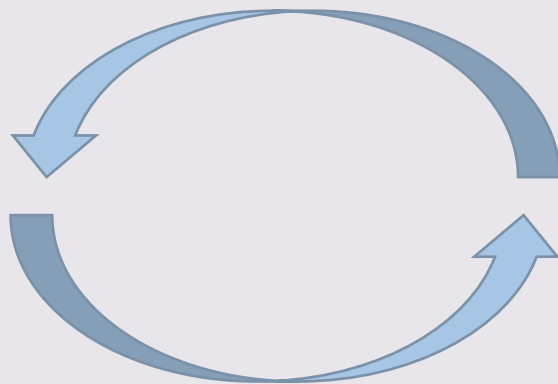

pud – feel shame impudent adj.

- to put new strength or power into something

replicate v. 重做; 复制,(病毒、分子)再造; 使再生; 自我复制

the ability of DNA to replicate itself

脱氧核糖核酸的自我复制能力

duplicate v. to copy something exactly

- repeat (information) without analyzing or comprehending it

- to feel angry or upset about a situation or about something that someone has done, especially because you think that it is not fair

consent v. (consensus)

dissent v. 持异议 n. 异议 (disagreement)

- If you dissent, you express disagreement with a decision or opinion, especially one that is supported by most people or by people in authority.
