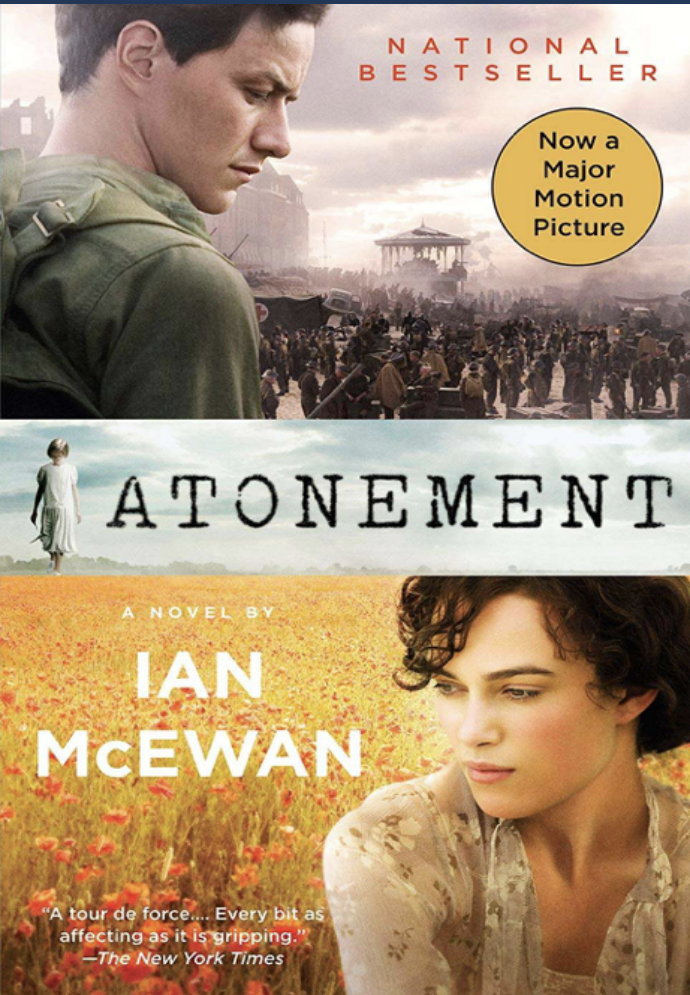

## Basic information about SAT reading

- Total questions: 52
- Total time: 65mins (on average, 75 secs per question)
- Number of passages: 4 single passages + 1 paired passages
- Number of questions per passage: 10 or 11
- Passage Length: 500-750 words per passage
- Total score: 400

- Subject:
  1. U.S. and world literature
  2. History (a U.S. founding document/the Great Global conversation)
  3. Social science (economics, sociology...)
  4. Natural science (earth science, biology, physics, chemistry...)

# The Declaration of Independence

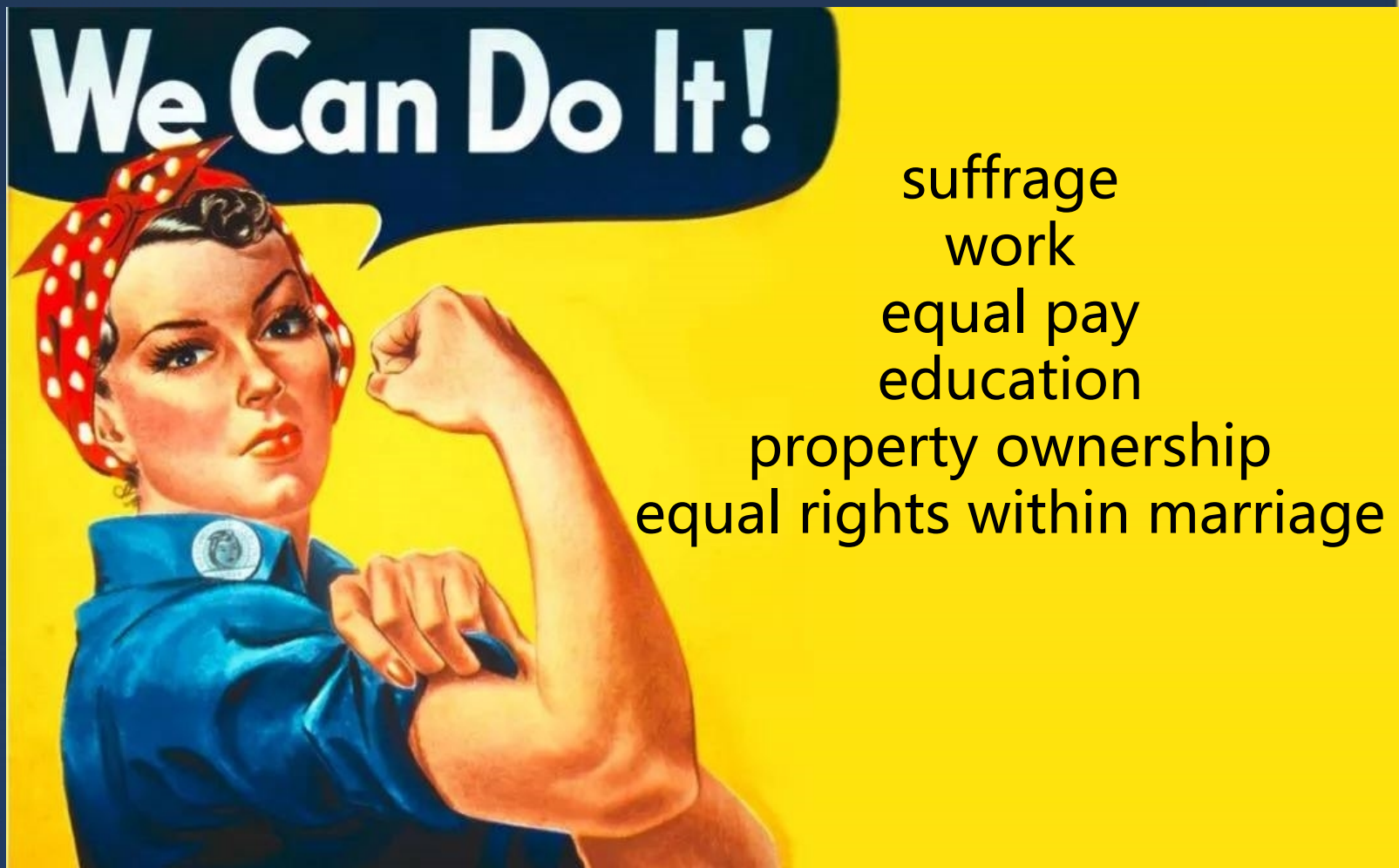

# the Constitutional Convention the Federal Convention the Philadelphia Convention



Although the Convention was intended to revise the league of states and first system of government under **the Articles of Confederation**, the intention from the outset of many of its proponents, chief among them James Madison of Virginia and Alexander Hamilton of New York, was to create a new government rather than fix the existing one. The result of the Convention was the creation of **the Constitution of the United States**.



# Closer look at SAT reading passages

- Purpose:
  1. to tell a story
  2. to recount an event or experience
  3. to reflect on an idea or a concept
  4. to present information and ideas
  5. to explain a process or concept
  6. to convince readers to believe something or to take some sort of action



# Closer look at SAT reading passages

- Paired passages: on the same topic and interact with one another in some way
- Informational graphics: locate information, draw reasonable conclusions, or make connections between the graphic and the passage



## Closer look at SAT reading questions

- All the questions are multiple-choice.
- Questions follow a natural order.
- No background knowledge is required.
- No penalty for wrong answers.
