- 52
- 65

- 500 to 750
- 400



Basic information about SAT reading

- Total questions: <u>52</u>
- Total time: <u>65mins</u> (on average, <u>75</u> secs per question)
- Number of passages: <u>4</u> single passages + <u>1</u> paired passages
- Number of questions per passage: <u>10 or 11</u>
- Passage Length: <u>500-750</u> words per passage
- Total score: <u>400</u>

- Subject:
- 1. U.S. and world literature
- 2. <u>History (a U.S. founding document/the Great</u> Global conversation)
- 3. Social science (economics, sociology...)
- 4. <u>Natural science</u>(earth science, biology, physics, chemistry...)

Although the Convention was intended to revise the league of states and first system of government under the Articles of Confederation, the intention from the outset of many of its proponents, chief among them James Madison of Virginia and Alexander Hamilton of New York, was to create a new government rather than fix the existing one. The result of the Convention was the creation of the Constitution of the United States.

Closer look at SAT reading passages

- Purpose:
- 1. to tell a story
- 2. to recount an event or experience
- 3. to reflect on an idea or a concept
- 4. to present information and ideas
- 5. to explain a process or concept
- 6. to convince readers to believe something or to take some sort of action



Closer look at SAT reading passages

- Paired passages: on the same topic and interact with one another in some way
- Informational graphics: locate information, draw reasonable conclusions, or make connections between the graphic and the passage



Closer look at SAT reading questions

- All the questions are multiple-choice.
- Questions follow a natural order.
- No background knowledge is required.
- No penalty for wrong answers.
